

 9. Liquid clay that seals clay to clay after it is scored.
 10. When you create pottery starting with a ball of clay and pinch the sides to thin them out.
 11. When the clay has completely dried out; color of the clay has changed.

13. Clay in "pancake" form; even consistency is key.

16. Ceramics that have been glazed.
