
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Clinical Terms: Muscle System

- 5. Any muscular disease
- 7. Condition of great resistance to the stretch of muscle
- **8.** When muscle fibers tear if overstretched. Common among athletes
- 14. Prolonged muscle spasm
- **17.** Inflammation of fibrous connective tissues, especially in muscle fascia. Another name for fibrositis is muscular rheumatism
- **18.** Pain from any muscular disease or disorder
- **19.** When a tendon becomes painfully inflamed and swollen following injury of the repeated stress of athletic activity
- **20.** Partial or slight inability to move muscles

- **21.** Group of inherited disorders in which deficiency of dystrophin or associated glycoproteins collapses muscle cells.
- **22.** Degenerative disease in which fibrous connective tissue replaces skeletal muscle tissue

- 1. Spontaneous contractions of individuals muscle fibers, producing rapid and uncoordinated activity within muscle.
- 2. Technique for recording electrical changes in muscle tissues
- 3. Study of muscles
- 4. Cutting of muscle tissue
- **6.** Series of involuntary contractions of various voluntary muscles

- **9.** Chronic disease in which muscles are weak and easily fatigued because of malfunctions of neuromuscular systems
- 10. Soreness on front of leg due to straining of anterior leg muscles, often result of walking up and down hills
- 11. Any muscular disease
- **12.** Inflammation of skeletal muscle tissue
- **13.** Persistent quivering of muscle
- **15.** Condition where the neck contracts involuntarily. It is also referred to as wryneck
- **16.** Tumor composed of muscle tissue
