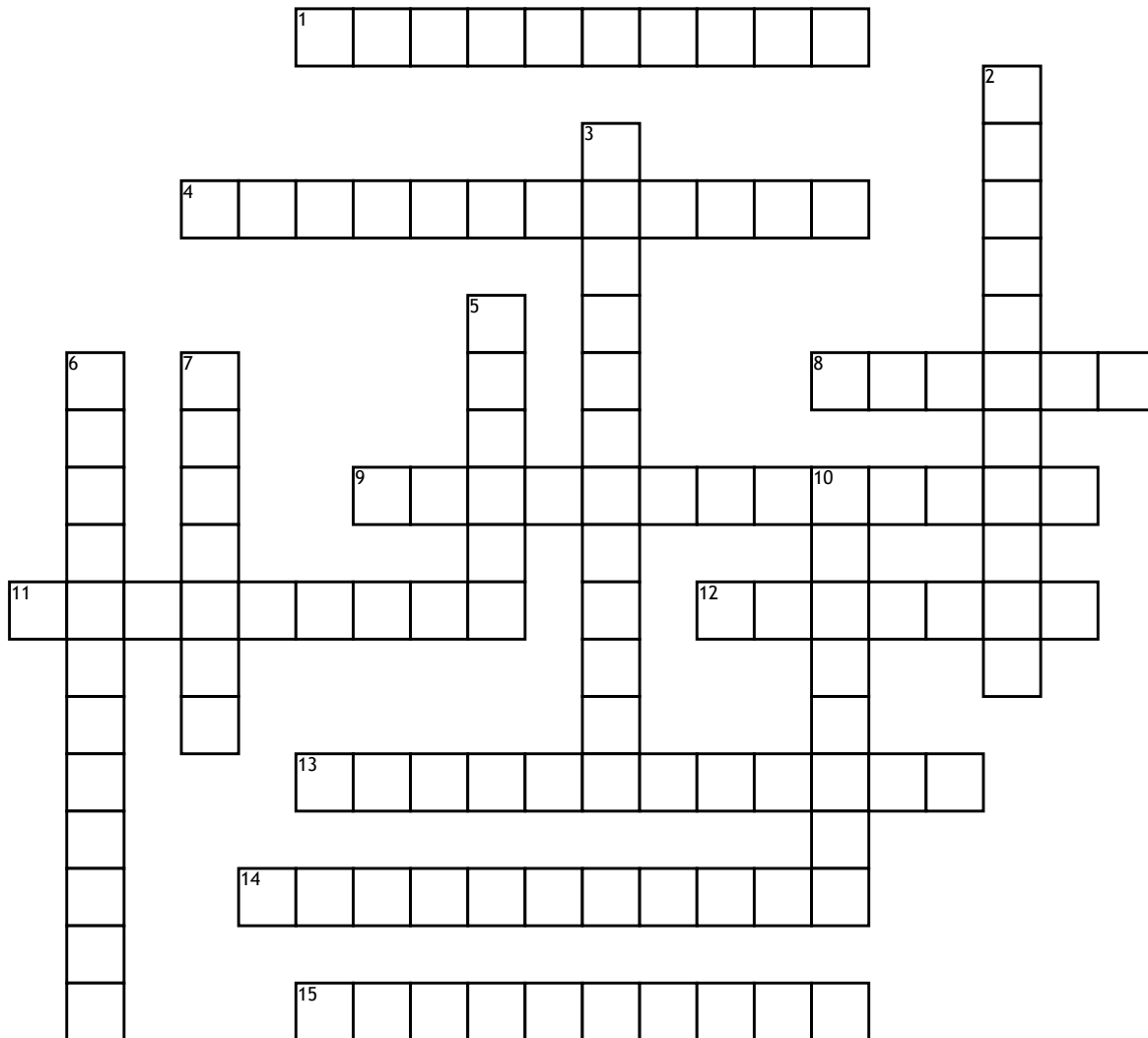

1. are shaped like lenses or almonds or flying saucers. They may get their shape from hilly terrain or just the way the air is rising over flat terrain.

4. grow on hot days when warm, wet air rises very high into the sky.

8. a visible mass of condensed water vapor floating in the atmosphere, typically high above the ground

9. clouds are patchy gray or white clouds that often have a dark honeycomb-like appearance.

11. are made by high-flying jet airplanes. They are still clouds, though, because they are made of water droplets condensed from the water vapor in the exhaust of the jet engines.

12. clouds that look like fluffy, white cotton balls in the sky.

13. clouds are thin, white clouds that cover the whole sky like a veil.

14. clouds are gray or blue-gray mid-level clouds composed of ice crystals and water droplets.

15. clouds get their shape from mountains or hills that force the air to move over or around them.

2. clouds have several patchy white or gray layers, and seem to be made up of many small rows of fluffy ripples.

3. clouds are dark, gray clouds that seem to fade into falling rain or snow.

5. Delicate, feathery clouds that are mostly made of ice crystals.

6. clouds are thin, sometimes patchy, sheet-like clouds.

7. often look like thin, white sheets covering the whole sky.

10. are actually altocumulus, cirrus, cumulonimbus, or other types of clouds that have these pouch-like shapes hanging out of the bottom.
