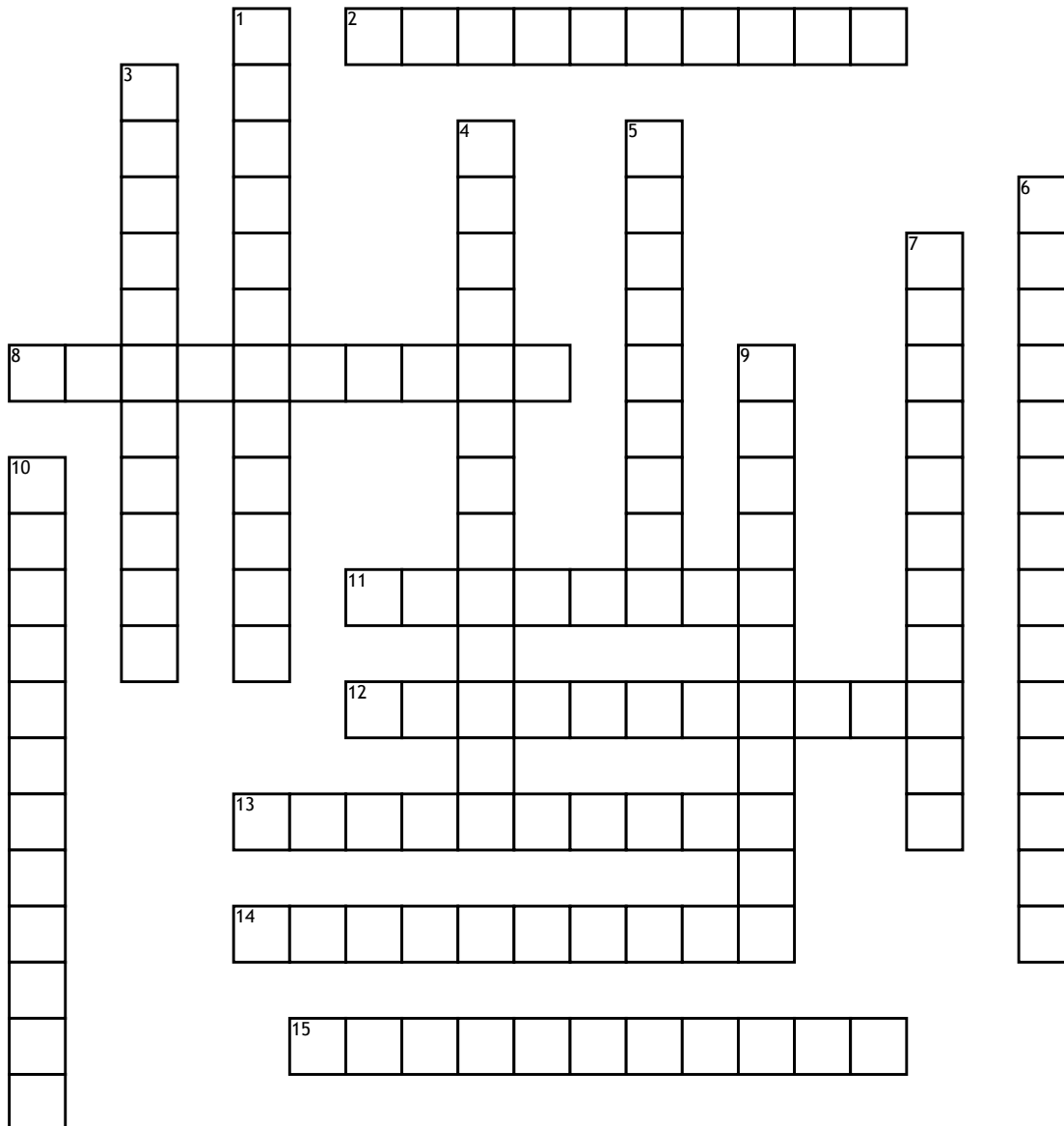


Cnidarians Vocab Crossword

2. corals having pink or red color characterized by a calcareous skeleton, in a variety of shapes often forming reefs

8. a marine polyp with a calcareous skeleton that lives in colonies

11. consists of interconnected neurons lacking a brain

12. a sense organ consisting of a sac enclosing sensory hairs and particles. It indicates position in space

13. consist of a cell body, which contains a nucleus and receives incoming nerve impulses

14. taxonomic class of individually very small, predatory animals living in salt water

15. surface where the mouth is located

1. eight rows or filia used for locomotion that do not have nematocyst

3. a class of invertebrate marine animals which comprises the jelly fish

4. surface situated opposite to or away from the mouth

5. a class of invertebrate marine animals which comprises sea anemones and corals

6. the common name given to a genus of marine corals. The skeleton is durable and intensely colored

7. a cell type found in ctenophores, they are widespread in tentacles and used to capture prey

9. a specialized cell in the tentacles of a jelly fish or other aquatic animals, containing a venomous coiled thread that can be projected in self defense

10. A class of marine animals belonging to phylum cnidaria, often subtly colored or transparent
