

1. Managing the wider coastal zone from coastal hazards, as well minimising environmental and ecological impacts.

2. Coasts are divided into natural compartments containing sediment sources, transport paths and sinks.

4. Occurs when erosion gets behind cpastal defences, leading to rapid erosion inland.
5. Prevents mass movement.
6. It can be used on any waterway or water containment where there is potential for water erosion.

7. Works with natural processes to reduce coastal erosion and flood threat.
