

- 1. A massive program of airlifting supplies of essential goods to West Berliners undertaken from June 1948 to September 1949.
- 3. identification with one's own nation and support for its interests, especially to the exclusion or detriment of the interests of other nations.
- 4. an American foreign policy whose stated purpose was to contain Soviet geopolitical expansion during the Cold War
- 5. Quickly became a Cold War battleground between communist and non-communist countries.
- 6. was a United States policy using numerous strategies to prevent the spread of communism abroad.

- 7. A military alliance of communist nations in eastern Europe. Organized in 1955 in answer to NATO, the Warsaw Pact included Bulgaria, Czechoslovakia, East Germany, Hungary, Poland, Romania, and the Soviet Union
- 8. the line on the map that marks the border between North Korea and South Korea, established in 1945 after the Second World War.
- 9. s the name given to a period of improved relations between the United States and the Soviet Union that began tentatively in 1971 and took decisive form when President Richard M. Nixon visited the secretary-general of the Soviet Communist party, Leonid I.
- 10. a notional barrier separating the former Soviet bloc and the West prior to the decline of communism that followed the political events in eastern Europe in 1989.
