

- 2. Communist-dominated Vietnamese Nationalist Movement; operated out of base in southern China during World War II
- **3.** Fought from 1950 to 1953; North supported by U.S.S.R. and later People's Republic of China
- **8.** Phrased coined by Winston Churchill to describe the division between free and communist societies taking shape in Europe after 1946.
- **9.** One of the more pragmatic, least ideological of the Communist leaders of China; joined the party as a young man in the 1920s
- **10.** The state of relations between the United States and its allies and the Soviet Union and its allies between restore his dominance over pragmatists the end of World War II and 1990

- 1. Stalin's successor as head of U.S.S.R. from 1953 to 1964; attacked Stalinism in 1956 for concentration of power and arbitrary dictatorship

- **5.** Built in 1961 to halt the flow of immigration form East Berlin to West Berlin
