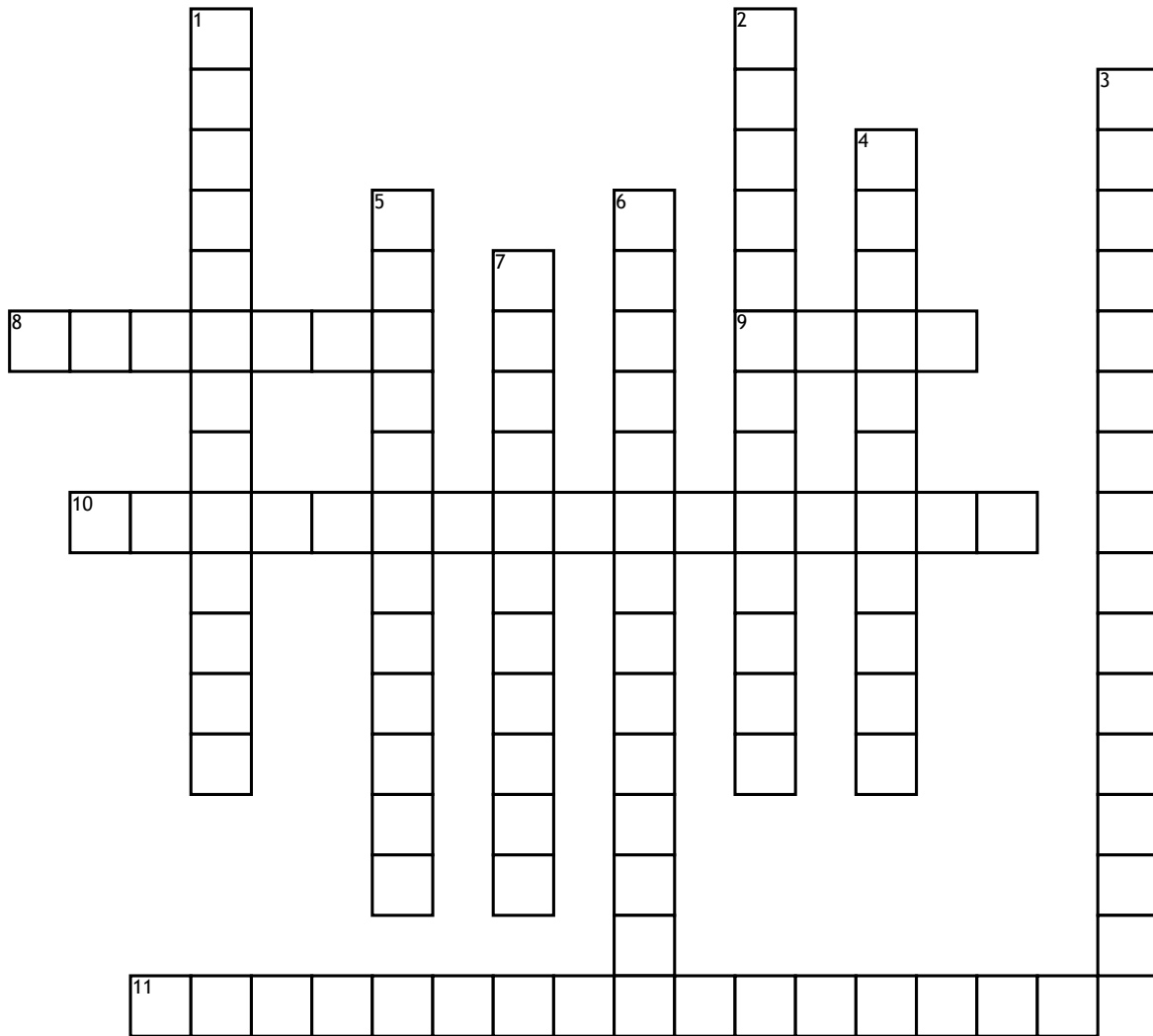


Cold War Vocabulary

- 10. meeting between Allied nations (Great Britain, United States, Soviet Union) to negotiate terms for the end of WWII
- 11. nations under the influence and pressure of the Soviet Union

- 1. International organization established after WWII to maintain peace and cooperation throughout the world

- 2. 11 month crisis where Soviets blockaded Berlin and Allies sent supplies
- 3. meeting between Allied nations (Great Britain, United States, Soviet Union) at the end of WWII in order to make important decisions regarding the future of the war and post-war world.
- 4. U.S. foreign policy directed at stopping the spread of Communism
- 5. assistance program that provided food, machinery, and other materials to rebuild Western Europe
- 6. provided aid (money, supplies) to Turkey and Greece to help rebuild after the war
- 7. represents the division between communist Eastern Europe and democratic Western Europe
