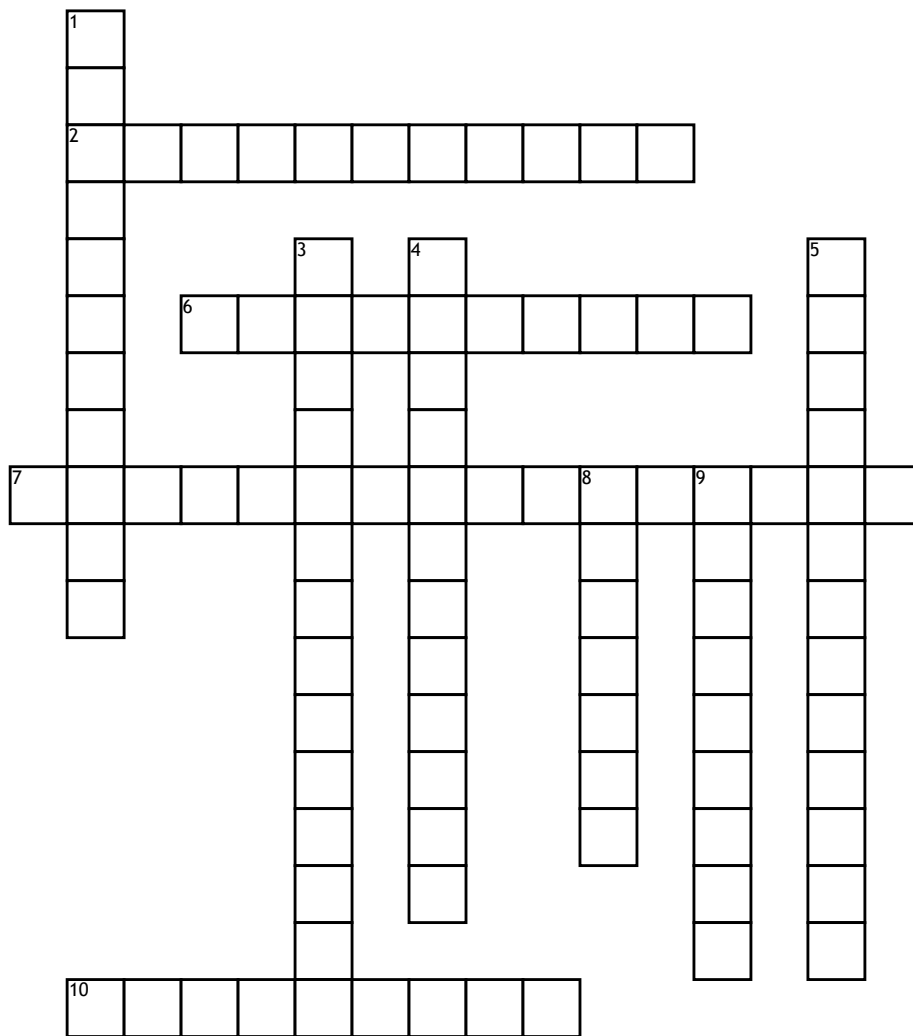

5. An international organization, with headquarters in New York City, formed to promote international peace, signed by 51 founding countries in 1945.

9. A political theory advocating a society in which all property is publicly owned and each person works and is paid accordingly to their abilities and needs, a single authoritarian party controls both the political and economic systems.
