

- 3. The first ever satellite launched into space. The USSR launched the communication satellite in 1957. This officially started the space race between the two countries.
- **6.** Failed CIA operation in April 1961 to overthrow Castro and take over Cuba using Cuban exiles. It was known as the perfect failure.
- 8. 33rd President of the United States. He fired General Douglass MacArthur over disagreements on the Korean War.
- 11. an American army general and statesman who served as the 34th President of the USA from 1953 to 1961. During World War II, he was a five-star general in the United States Army, Supreme Commander of the Allied Expeditionary Forces in Europe.

- 14. issued with a foreign policy goal of containing the spread of communism Down
- 1. 13 Day period in October 1962 when Soviet nuclear missile were pointed at the United States in Cuba.
- 2. The downing of a U.S. spy plane and capture of its pilot by the Soviet Union in 1960.
- **4.** The attacks, often unsubstantiated, by Senator Joseph McCarthy and others on people suspected of being Communist in the early 1950s.
- **5.** The idea that if a nation falls under communist control, nearby nations will also fall under communist control
- **7.** The Allies response to the Soviets blockade of West Berlin

- **9.** A United States program of economic aid for the reconstruction of Europe (1948-1952)
- 10. A conflict between North Korea and South Korea, lasting from 1950-1953, in which the United States along with other UN countries, fought on the side of the South Koreans while China fought on the side of the North Koreans
- **12.** 35th President of the United States. Was in office during the Bay of Pigs Invasion, Cuban Missile Crisis and the building of the Berlin Wall.
- **13.** Separated East Berlin and West Berlin from 1961-1989
