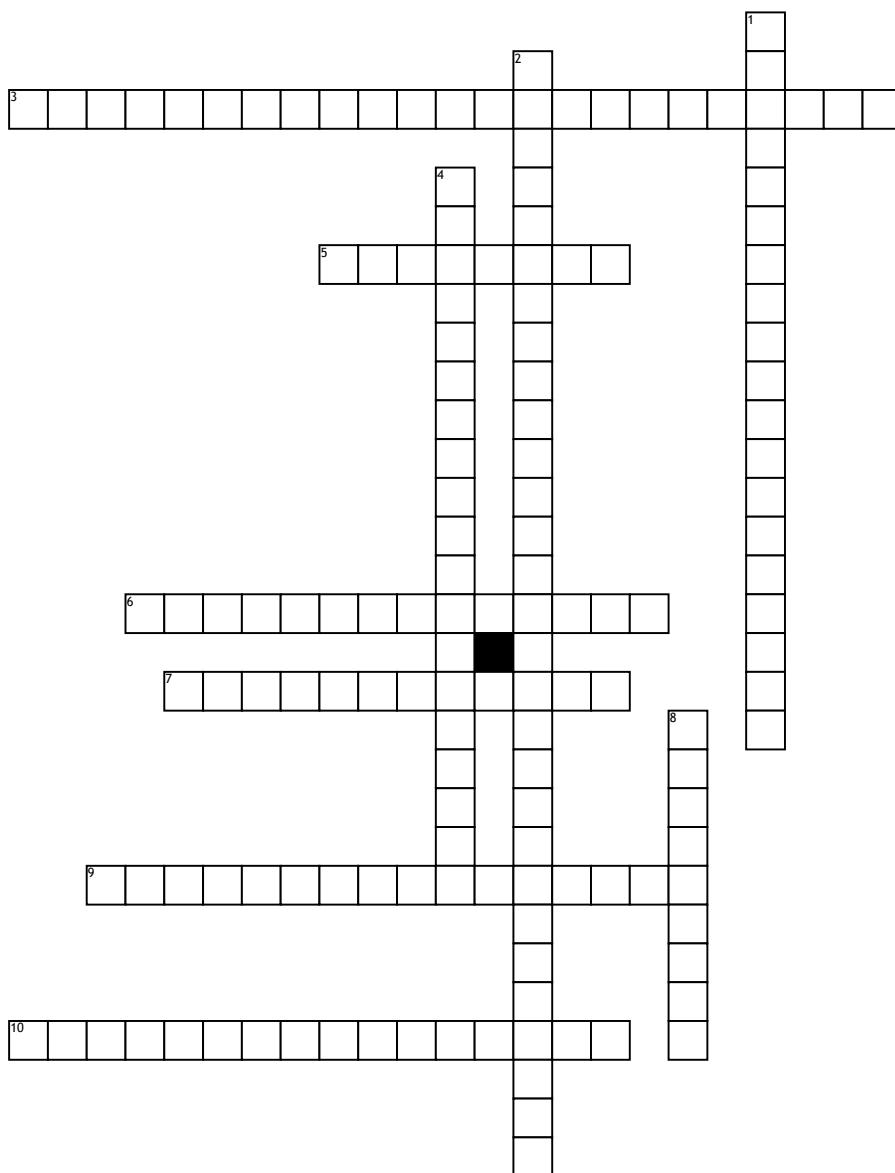

3. Weighted GPAs include an extra point on a 4.0-point scale for honors and advanced placement classes
5. College issue "acceptances' denials," and waitlist. Students waitlisted may be accepted later if other students already accepted or ahead of them on the waitlist choose not to go to that school
6. if and applicant qualifies based on FAFSA information, The US government pays for any interest accrued during college and gives a loan grace period after college graduation.
7. Includes information about the students class rank, GPA, Academic courses, attendance rate, and any discipline incidents. It may also include any letters of recommendation from the counselor and/or teachers

9. Primarily offer degrees in undergraduate and graduate programs that focus on fine and performing arts

10. Unlike subsidized loans, the government does not supplement interest accrued during college
