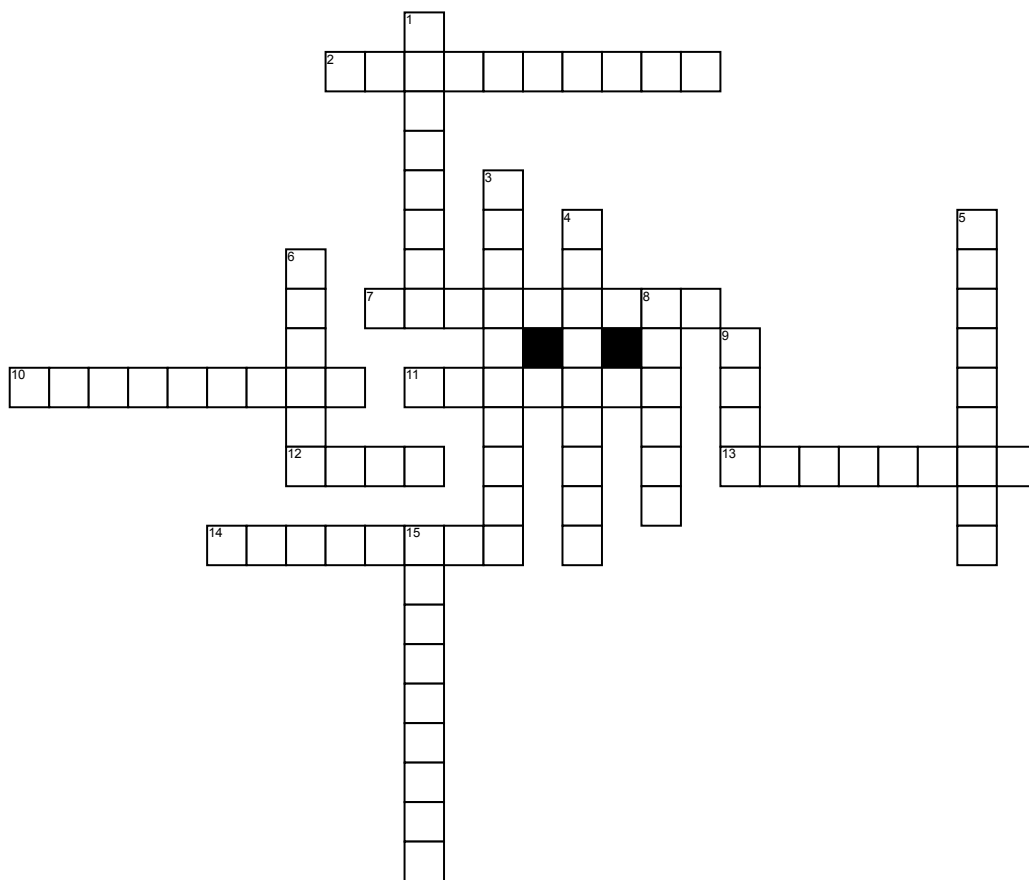


College Crossword Puzzle
