

- **4.** Money you receive for you college tuition or expenses that you may or may not have to pay back.
- 10. Time set aside by professors or teaching assistants for students to visit their office and ask questions or discuss the course they teach.
- **12.** A type of degree awarded to students at a US community college, usually after two years of classes.
- **13.** A degree awarded to undergraduates, usually after four years of college classes.
- **14.** : A class that must be taken before you can take a different class. (For example, Astronomy 100 may be a prerequisite for Astronomy 200.)

- **15.** A student who lives in and meets the residency requirements for the state where a public university is located.
- 17. Highest academic degree. Awarded after a masters degree

- **1.** Courses you take by computer instead of in a traditional classroom.
- **3.** A description of a course which also lists the dates of major exams, assignments and projects.
- **5.** A degree awarded to graduate students. The awarding of a master's degree requires at least one year of study (and often more, depending on the field) after a student earns a bachelor's degree.
- 6. Your primary area of study

- 7. A student who enrolls in at least a minimum number (determined by your college or university) of credit hours of courses.
- **8.** The number of hours assigned to a specific class.
- **9.** An official academic record from a specific school. It lists the courses you have completed, grades and information such as when you attended.
- 11. Type of academic term. A school with this system generally will have a fall semester and a spring semester (each about 15 weeks long)
- **16.** assigned by your college or university, who can help choose your classes and make sure you are taking the right courses to graduate.
