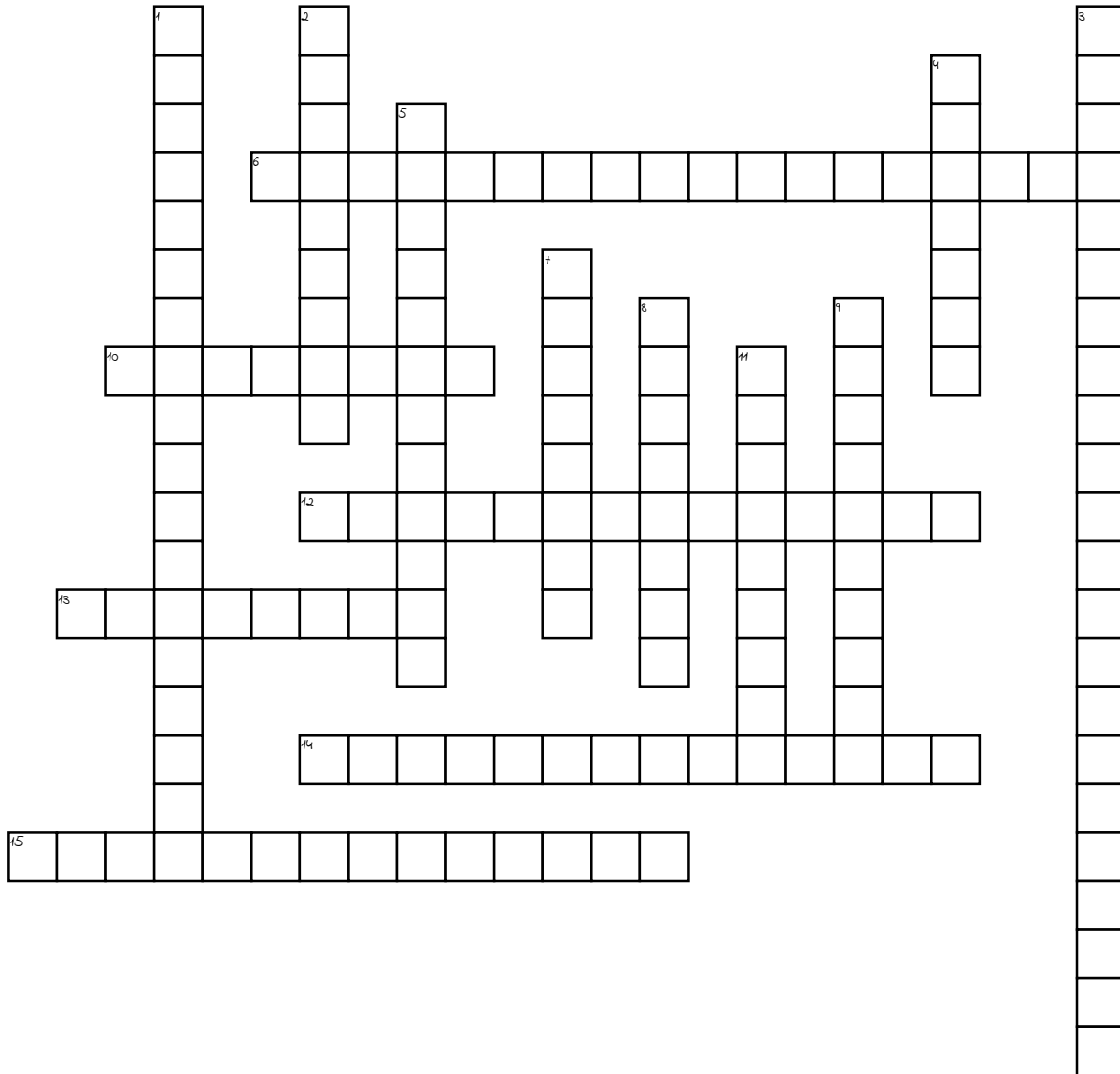


# Colonial Crossword Challenge
