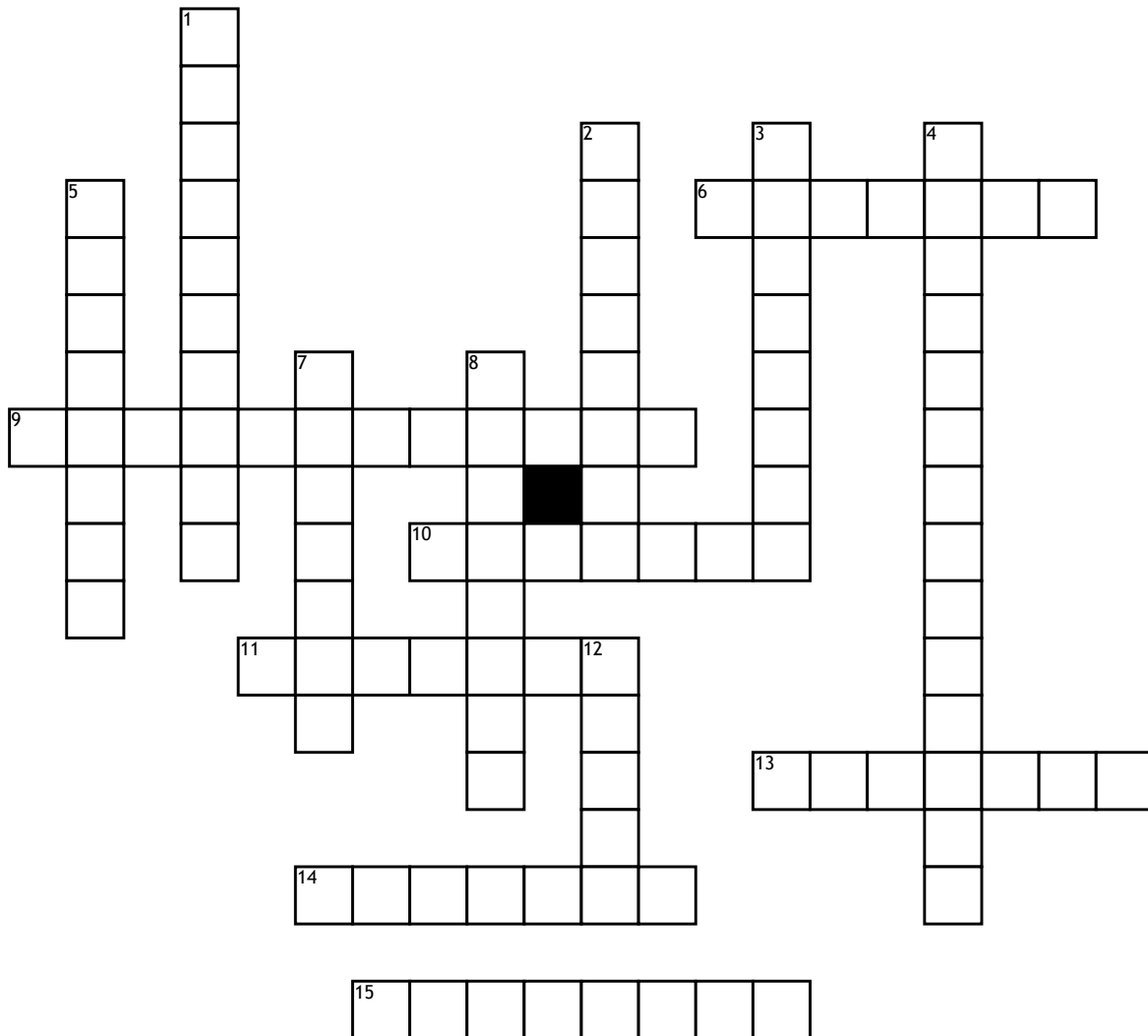


Colonial Times Crossword
