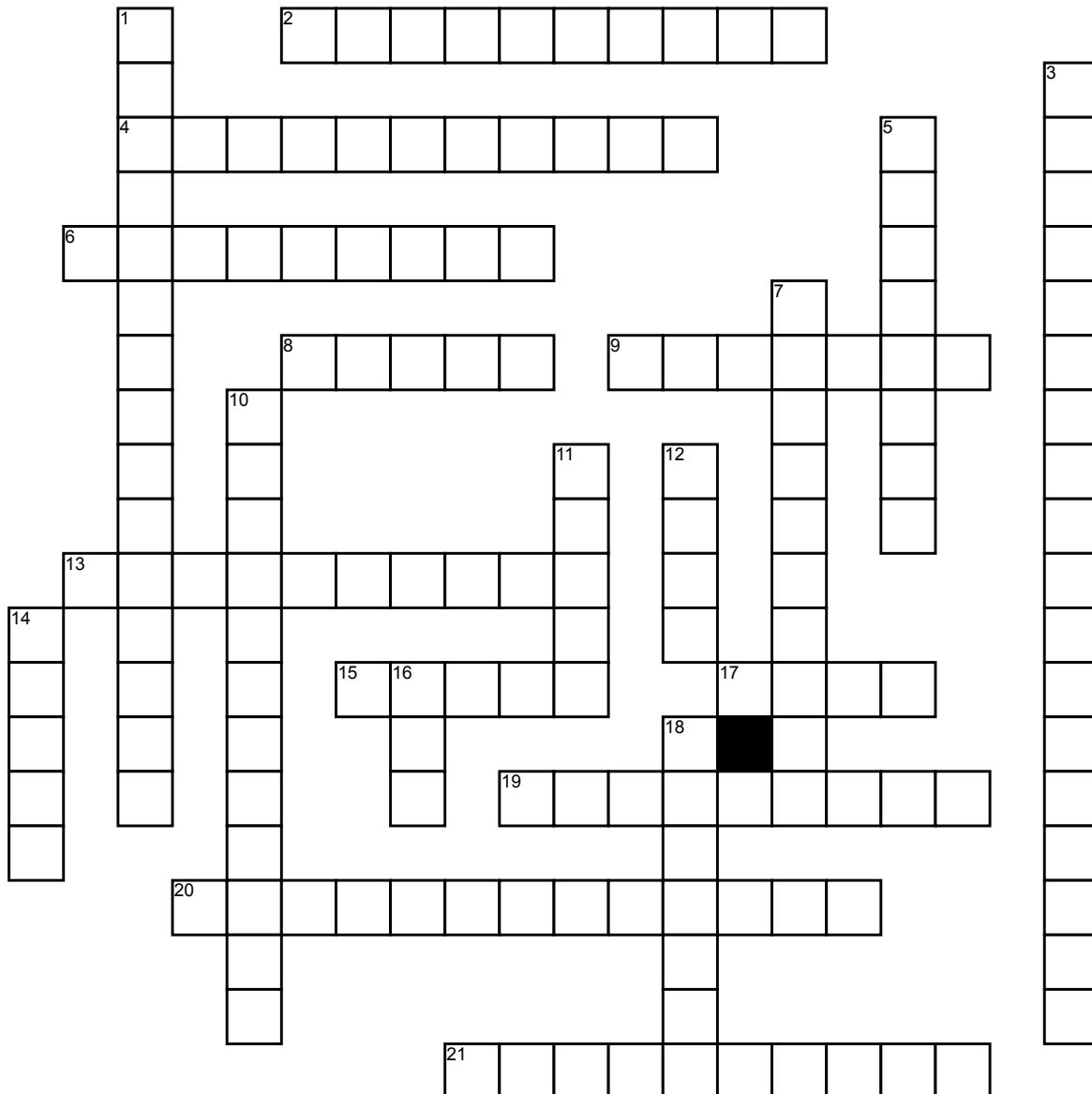


# Color Vocabulary



## Across

2. blue, green, and violet and the colors near them on the color wheel  
 4. the combination of colors selected for the design of a room or house  
 6. a color harmony created by combining related hues-those next to each other on the color wheel  
 8. an element or property of light  
 9. a color harmony created by combining any three colors that are equally distant from each other on a standard color wheel  
 13. a particular arrangement of primary, secondary, and tertiary colors  
 15. the addition of black to a hue to make it a darker value  
 17. the result of adding gray to a hue  
 19. the brightness or dullness of a hue

20. the full range of all existing colors

21. a hue that is directly across from another hue on the color wheel

## Down

1. the colors of orange, green and violet; made by mixing equal amounts of two primary colors  
 3. a color harmony consisting of one hue with the two hues adjacent to its complement  
 5. colors made by mixing equal amounts of primary color with a secondary color adjacent to it on the color wheel  
 7. red, yellow, and orange and the colors near them on the color wheel  
 10. a pleasing combination of colors based on their respective positions on the color wheel

11. the relative lightness or darkness of a hue

12. the addition of white to a hue to make it a lighter value

14. a mixture of pigment and liquid that thinly coats and covers a surface

16. the name of a color in its purest form with no added black, gray, or white

18. a color harmony using combinations of black, gray, and white. (browns also)
