
## Compartment Syndrome



## <u>Across</u>

**1.** Syndrome where pressure in compartment can cause tissue damage

3.

recognition of signs/symptoms is important in prevention of this syndrome.

**8.** capillary refill greater than 3 seconds, Late sign

**9.** Location where pressure monitor is found

**10.** \_\_\_\_\_monitor used by physician to determine if compartment syndrome present.

11. Key symptom & first "P"

**12.** "P" sign where skin is tight and shiny

**13.** 4th sign -unable to move extremity past injury site due to compressed nerves -late sign

## <u>Down</u>

2. very late sign & 6th "P" sign

**4.** Surgical procedure to reduce compartment pressure

5. 2nd "P" burning & tingling early sign

**6.** watch where you step so this soft tissue injury doesn't cause compartment syndrome

**7.** 75% of compartment syndromes caused by this injury
