

- **4**. only permanent birth control option, closes or blocks the fallopian tubes

- 6. small, bendable ring that you insert into vagina, gives off hormones that prevent your ovaries from releasing eggs

1. Placed in the uterus by a healthcare provider to prevent pregnancy.

- 2. applied to skin once a week for 3 weeks, gives off hormones to prevent egg release from ovaries
- 7. injection that contains progestin, a hormone that prevents the ovaries from releasing eggs
- 9. blocks the tubes that carry a man's sperm
- 10. Placed under the skin of the upper arm
