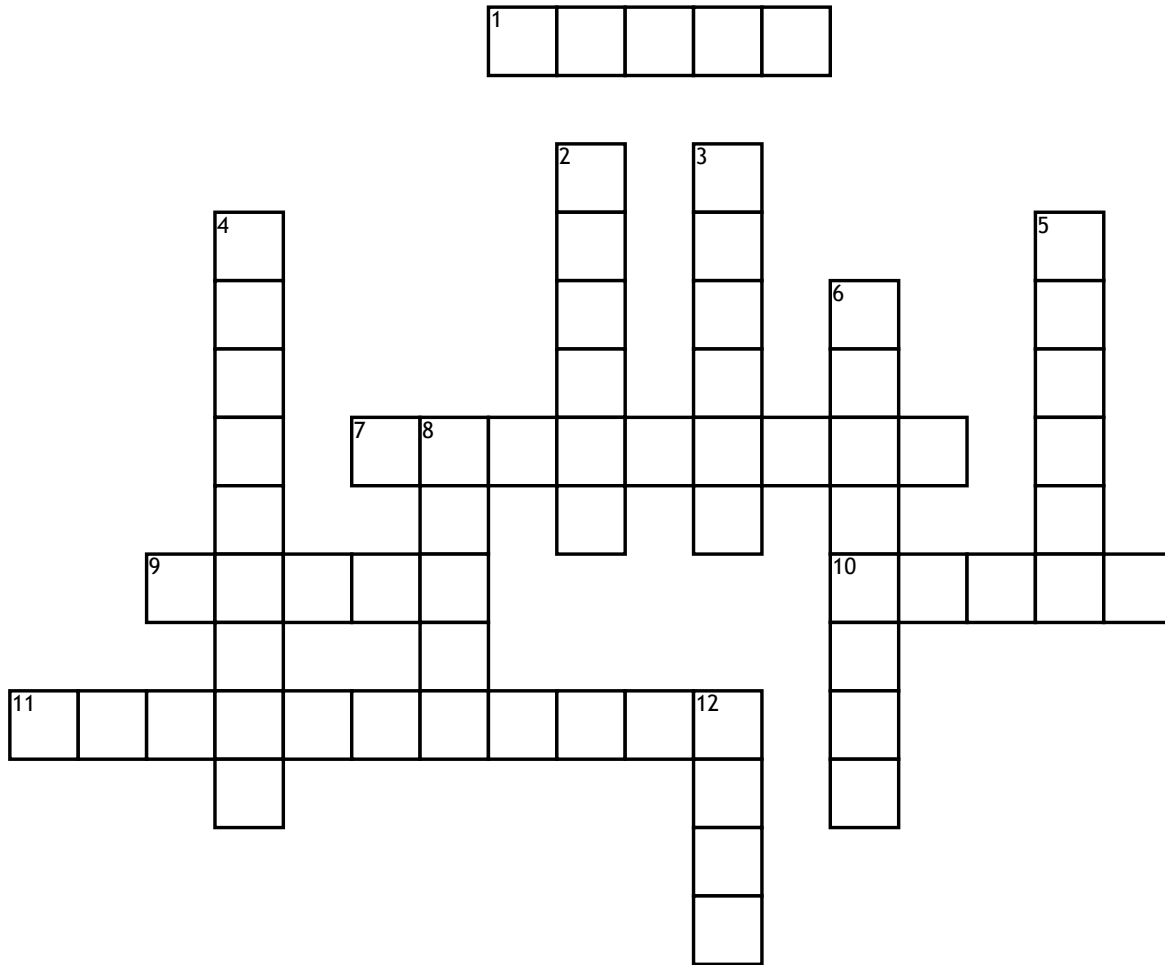


# Core Beliefs in Islam

2. Real beings, created by God from light, which have many functions and responsibilities. Belief in these is one of the six articles of faith.
3. The supreme will and power of God.
4. The concept within Islam of the belief in the importance of the Prophets and Prophethood.
5. The root of Shi'a Islam which refers to belief in the resurrection at the point of the Day of Judgement.

6. A concept in Shi'a Islam referring to the belief in 12 divinely appointed Imams who led the community from the Prophet's death until 9CE.
8. The branch of Islam that has formed its practice from its belief that the Prophet should have been succeeded by Abu Bakr.
12. The branch of Islam that has formed its practice from its belief that the Prophet should have been succeeded by his son-in-law, Ali.
