| 1. Closed hands (palms in, pointing forward) rub together at knuckles | A. Colour |
| 2. Closed hands (palms down, pointing forward) circle forwards several times | B. To climb |
| 3. Flat hands (palms back, pointing in), working hand on top swivels forwards and back | C. Milkshake |
| 4. Closed hands (palms in, pointing forward) tap knuckles together twice | D. Gate |
| 5. Fists (palms down, pointing forward) push forwards slightly | E. To have |
| 6. Working "N" hand (palm down, pointing forward/in) brushes along supporting palm and turns so that backs of fingers brush back to supporting fingertips | F. To cry |
| 7. Full "C" hands (palms in, pointing forward) move up and down alternately with gentle squeezing action; then working flat hand (palm down, pointing in) above supporting flat hand (palm up, pointing in); formation moves up and down twice | G. hot (weather) |
| 8. Make letter shape "P" , followed by letter shape "J" | H. Scissors |
| 9. Working flat hand (palm down, pointing forward/in) sweeps forwards off supporting flat hand (palm up, pointing forward/in) | I. Bicycle |
| 10. Flat hands (palms up) pointing diagonally to the side and front of body, move diagonally back into body) | J. Pram |
| 11. Clawed hands (palms forward, pointing up) move upwards alternately | K. Butter |
| 12. Index hands (palms back, pointing up) slowly trace tears down cheeks | L. Brother |
| 13. Working "V" hand (palm back/in, pointing forward/in); fingers close and open several times | M. To read |
| 14. Working clawed hands (palm in, pointing forward) swings back towards body closing into fist | N. Pyjamas |
| 15. Flat hands (palms together, pointing forward) open to palms up, little fingers remaining in contact; then tilt formation upwards and move slightly from side to side | O. Clean |
| 16. Working open hand (palm forward, pointing up) moves down in wavy line | P. Paper |
| 17. Working flat hand (palm back, pointing in) moves across forehead to working side | Q. To bring |
