

- **15.** Militaristic leader of Germany from 1888 until the end of World War I

- 3. The system of alliance intended to create peace through strength in Europe

- **5.** A policy of acquiring land, sending settlers, and exploiting it economically
- **6.** This man attempted to maintain Europe's balance of power while building Germany's strength in the years immediately following unification.

- **7.** Germany, Austria-Hungary, Ottoman Empire, Bulgaria
- **8.** A policy of empire building by extending territorial and economic control
- **10.** Bismark's pragmatic and diplomatic approach to establishing Germany as a world power
- **11.** Competition to build the strongest navy
- **13.** Germany TWICE nearly caused war over this country in an attempt to test the strength of the alliance between France and Britain
