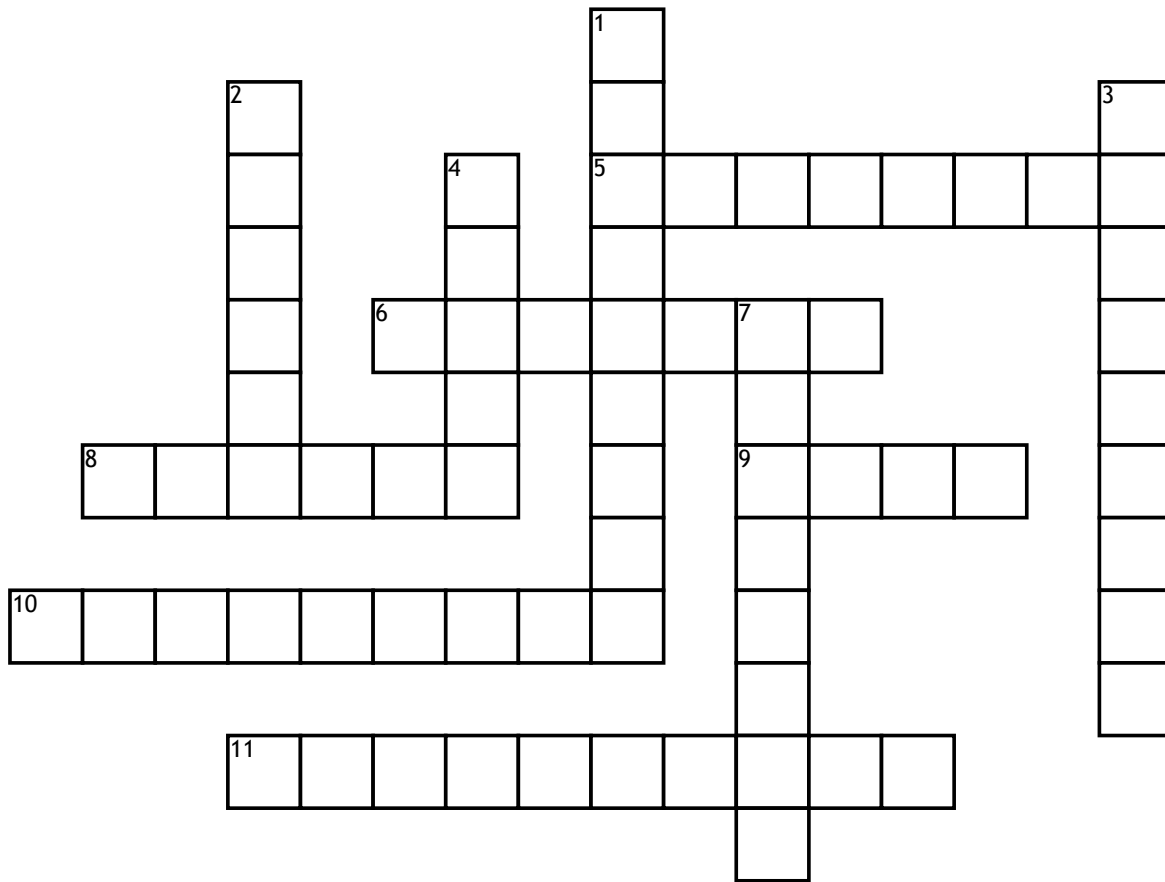

5. The punishment ordered by a court for a defendant convicted of a crime.
6. To put off a court date until another time or place.
8. The release of a person from prison before the end of their sentence. It requires supervision of the person and says what they can or cannot do for a certain amount of time.
9. In a criminal case, the defendant's statement pleading "guilty" or "not guilty" in answer to the charges.
10. Statements made by witnesses under oath.
11. The formal charge issued by a grand jury stating that there is enough evidence that the defendant committed the crime to justify having a trial; it is used primarily for felonies.

Down

1. The process in which the defendant and their legal counsel obtain information about the evidence (facts, documents, or testimony) held by the prosecutor regarding the defendant's case.
2. Someone licensed to represent clients in court and to give legal advice.
3. The person being accused of a crime
4. A public official appointed to preside over trial and hearings, and decide cases in a court of law. The judge is responsible for keeping order in the court and to decide on the type of sentence and/or length of sentence.
7. From the term "Record of Arrests and Prosecutions." It is a written list of a person's criminal history.
