

## **Across**

- **6.** only movable joint in the skull
- **7.** passageway between the middle ear and the nasopharynx
- **9.** irregularly shaped air-containing cavity located between the external and internal ear portions
- **11.** horseshoe shape of the mandible is well visualized on what projection

- **12.** rests on the superior end of the vertebral column
- **14.** is the slight depression above each eyebrow
- **15.** lie in the body of the sphenoid bone directly below the sella turcica

## Down

- 1. U-shaped notch
- **2.** forms the posterior part of the hard plate
- **3.** older term for maxillary sinuses

- **4.** located between the inner and outer tables of the skull, posterior to the glabella
- **5.** certain regions where sutures join are slower in their ossification
- **8.** smooth, raised prominence between the eyebrows just above the bridge of the nose
- **10.** most anterior of the three parts of the osseous
- **13.** lateral portions of the petrous ridges sit at this level
