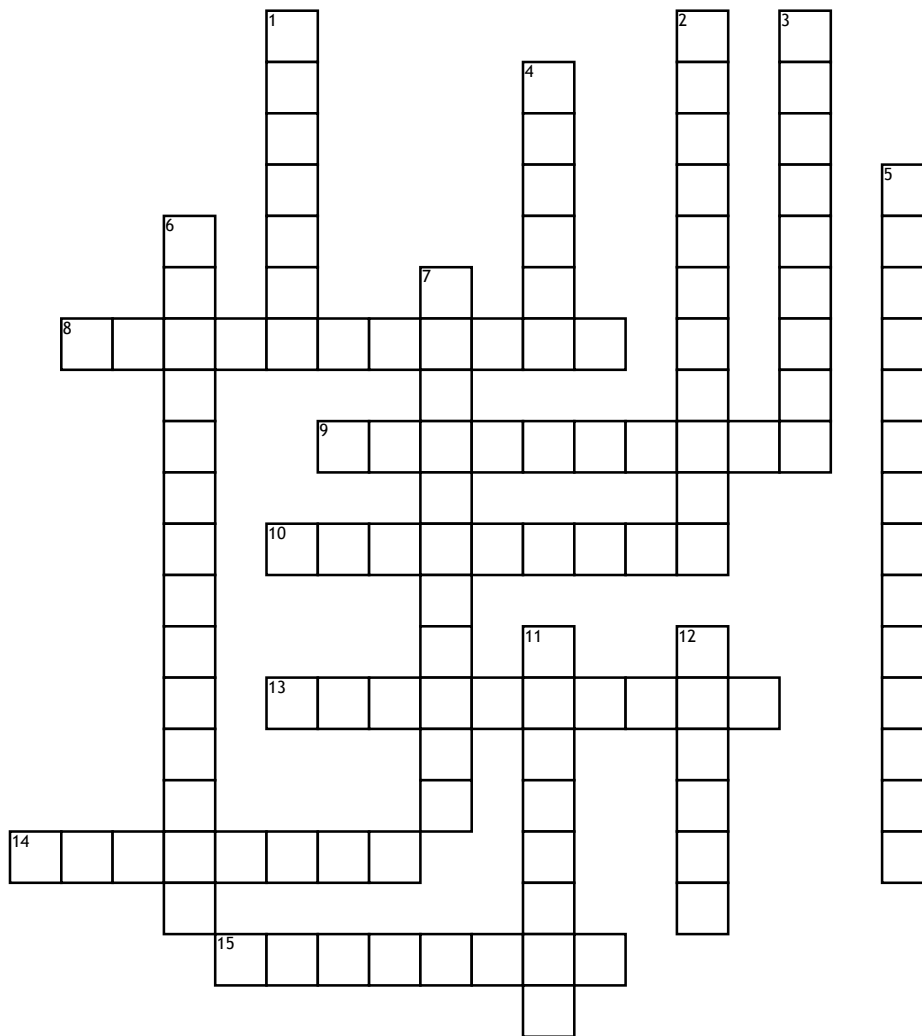


Crayfish Structures and their Functions
