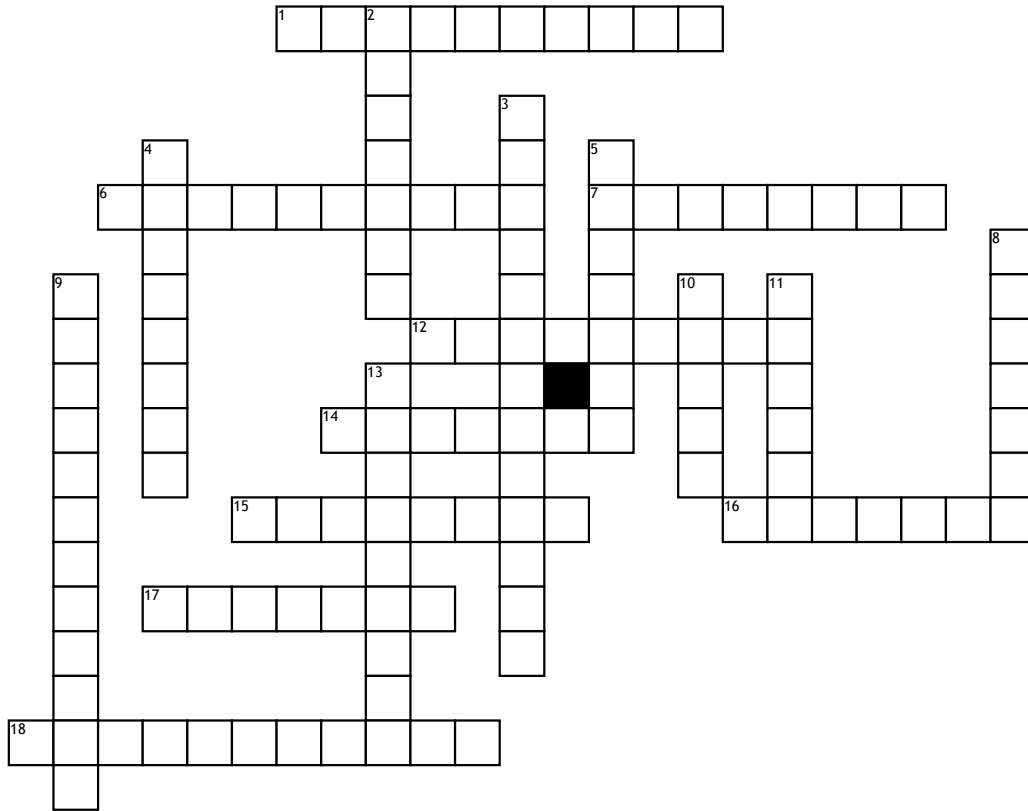


Creation of the Constitution
