
Crime and Punishment

- **5.** Aim of punishment; the punishment exists because the law does.

- **19.** Something (or someone) considered to be morally wrong; wicked; often linked to the idea of a malevolent force e.g. the devil.
- 20. Persons under 18 who commit a crime.
- **21.** The enforcement of rules e.g. by a police force
- **22.** Aim of punishment; helping the person see how and why they should behave better.
- **23.** Aim of punishment; making up for, compensating

- 1. Punishment; monitoring of behaviour with the threat of a greater punishment for offending again

- **3.** Sense of right and wrong; usually the guilty voice in our head
- **4.** Punishment; criminal has to do a set number of hours' work in the community as their punishment
- **7.** The one against whom the crime is committed
- **9.** A crime committed because of prejudice e.g. beating someone up because you think they are gay; in the UK law, it can mean doubling of a sentence if found guilty.
- 10. Making things fair again
- **14.** The rules which govern a country to keep us safe
- 15. Aim of punishment; to keep people safe
- **18.** Aim of punishment; getting back at a person for what they have done
