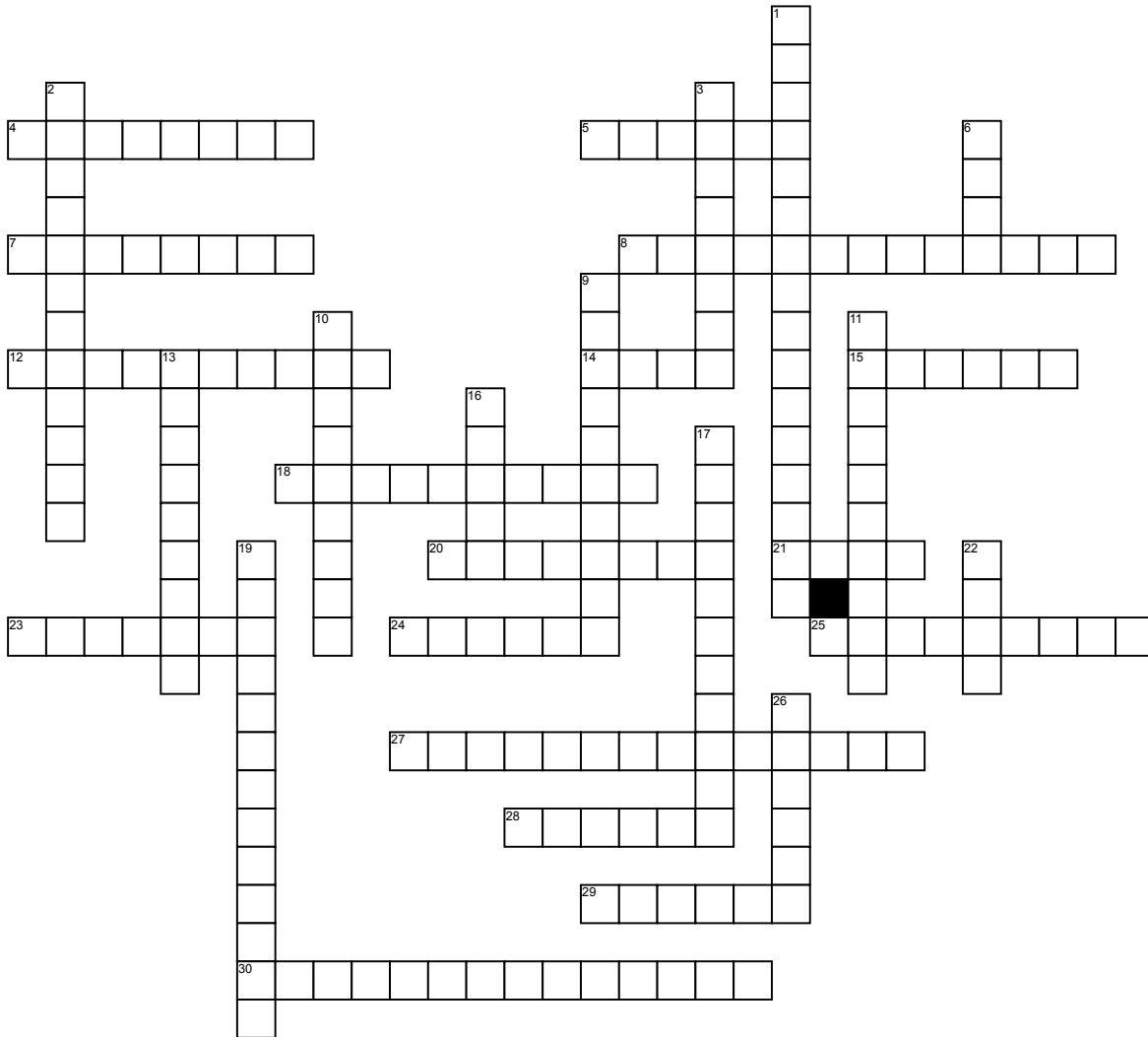


# Criminal Pleas Crossword Puzzle
