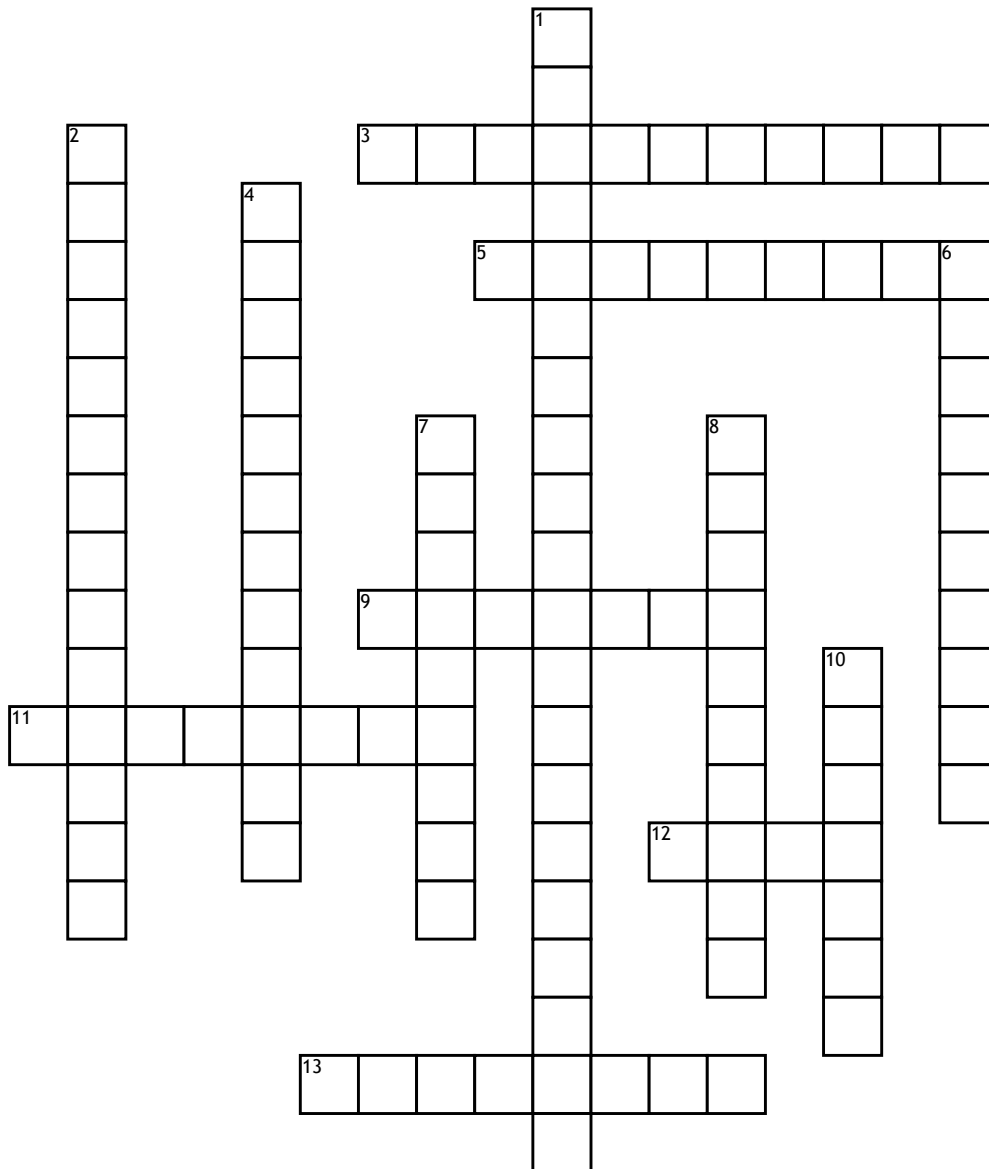


Crispy Crossword
