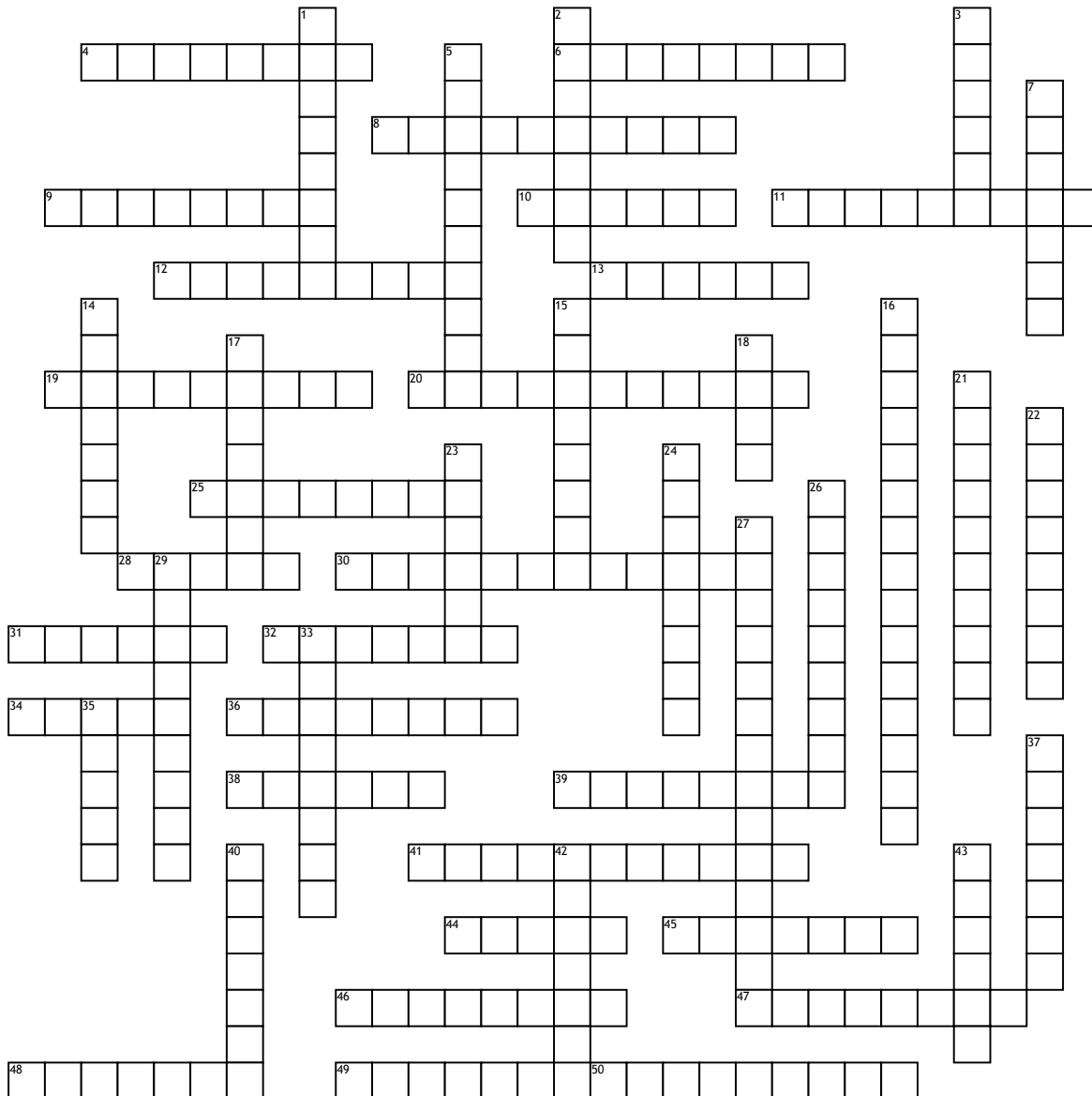

## Across

4. A small rounded projection or protuberance, especially on a bone.  
 6. The end of the scapular spine. \_\_\_\_\_ process.  
 8. Third wrist carpal.  
 9. \_\_\_\_\_ neck of the humerus separates the head of the humerus from the tuberosities.  
 10. Eighth wrist carpal.  
 11. Articulates with the trochlea of the humerus. \_\_\_\_\_ notch.  
 12. Fifth wrist carpal.  
 13. Radial \_\_\_\_\_ on the center of the lateral border of the humerus.  
 19. Where the radius articulates with the humerus.  
 20. These bones form the intermediate part of the hand.

 41. Concave depression located on anterior surface of scapula. \_\_\_\_\_ fossa.  
 44. Thin ridge of the scapula.  
 45. In anatomy, a \_\_\_\_\_ is a projection or outgrowth of tissue from a larger body.  
 46. First wrist carpal.  
 47. \_\_\_\_\_ neck of humerus, located below the tubercles.

 2. Smaller epicondyle of the humerus.  
 3. The larger and more prominent epicondyle of the humerus.  
 5. A protuberance above or on the condyle of a long bone.  
 7. Lateral tubercle located on the humerus. \_\_\_\_\_ tubercle.  
 14. Cartilage that makes up synovial joint.  
 15. The scapula and clavicle make up the \_\_\_\_\_ girdle.

16. Groove separating the greater and lesser tubercles of the humerus.  
 17. Long bone in the arm.  
 18. In anatomical position, the medial bone of the forearm.  
 21. A large rough projection of bone, generally serving for the attachment of a muscle.  
 22. Seventh wrist carpal.  
 23. Projection on medial side of radius. \_\_\_\_\_ tuberosity.  
 24. Fourth wrist carpal.  
 26. Refers to the back of the human body.  
 27. Posterior surface of scapula. \_\_\_\_\_ fossa.  
 29. Large depression on distal, posterior view of humerus. \_\_\_\_\_ fossa.  
 33. Small depression on distal, anterior view of humerus. \_\_\_\_\_ fossa.  
 35. Lateral radial \_\_\_\_\_ on the ulna where the radius articulates.  
 37. Where the humerus articulates with the scapula. \_\_\_\_\_ fossa.  
 40. "Bump" visible on anterior view of humerus. \_\_\_\_\_ tuberosity.  
 42. "Bump" on inferior, acromial end of clavicle. \_\_\_\_\_ process.  
 43. The \_\_\_\_\_ phalanges are the bones at the tips of the fingers.
