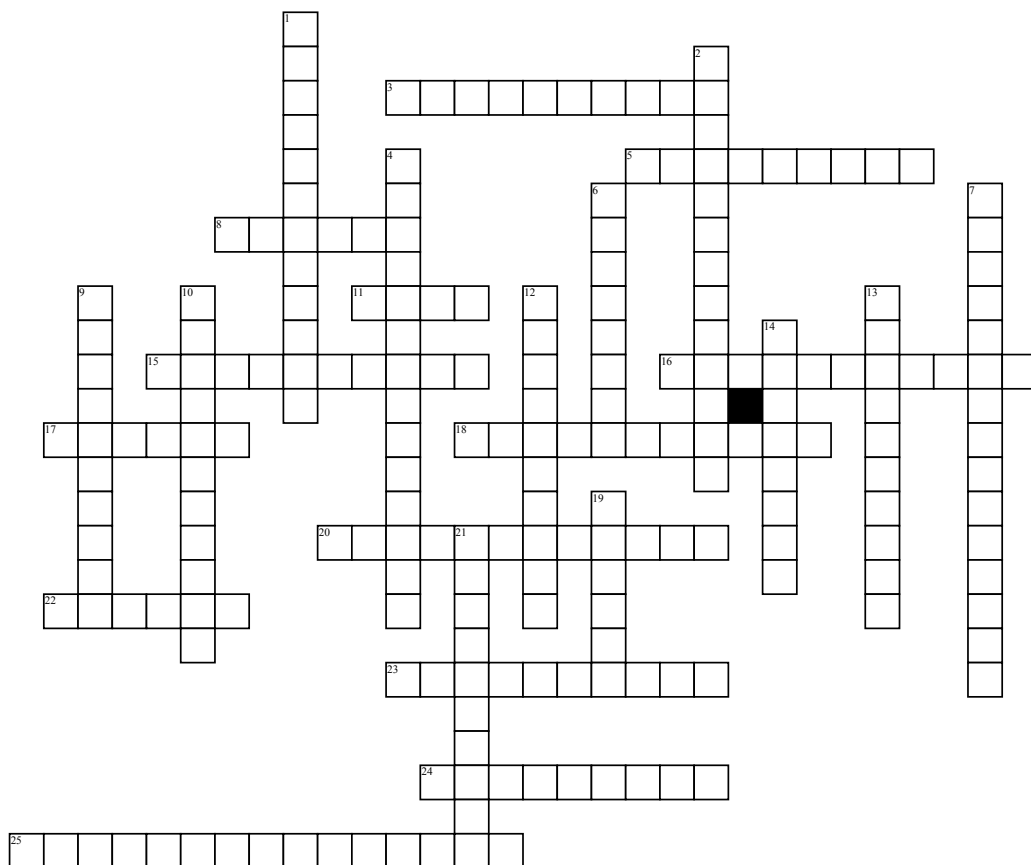

 11. a fixed income instrument that represents a loan made by an investor to a borrower (typically corporate or governmental)
 15. the yield the bond paid on its issue date
 16. the loss incurred when a capital asset, such as an investment or real estate, decreases in value
 17. a type of security that signifies proportionate ownership in the issuing corporation
 18. a rise in the value of a capital asset that gives it a higher worth than the purchase price
 20. the issuer must redeem the bond by paying the principal or face value.
 22. units of ownership interest in a corporation or financial asset that provide for an equal distribution in any profits

23. a condition in which securities prices fall 20% or more from recent highs amid widespread pessimism and negative investor sentiment

24. bonds that carry a higher risk of default than most bonds issued by corporations and governments
 25. a bond issued by a national government, generally with a promise to pay periodic interest payments called coupon payments and to repay the face value on the maturity date

 4. a debt security issued by a corporation and sold to investors
 6. the charge for the privilege of borrowing money, typically expressed as annual percentage rate
 7. the process of allocating capital in a way that reduces the exposure to any one particular asset or risk

9. a sudden dramatic decline of stock prices across a significant cross-section of a stock market, resulting in a significant loss of paper wealth

10. a professional who executes buy and sell orders for stocks and other securities on behalf of clients

12. a disclosure document that describes a financial security for potential buyers

14. a payment made by a corporation to its shareholders, usually as a distribution of profits
