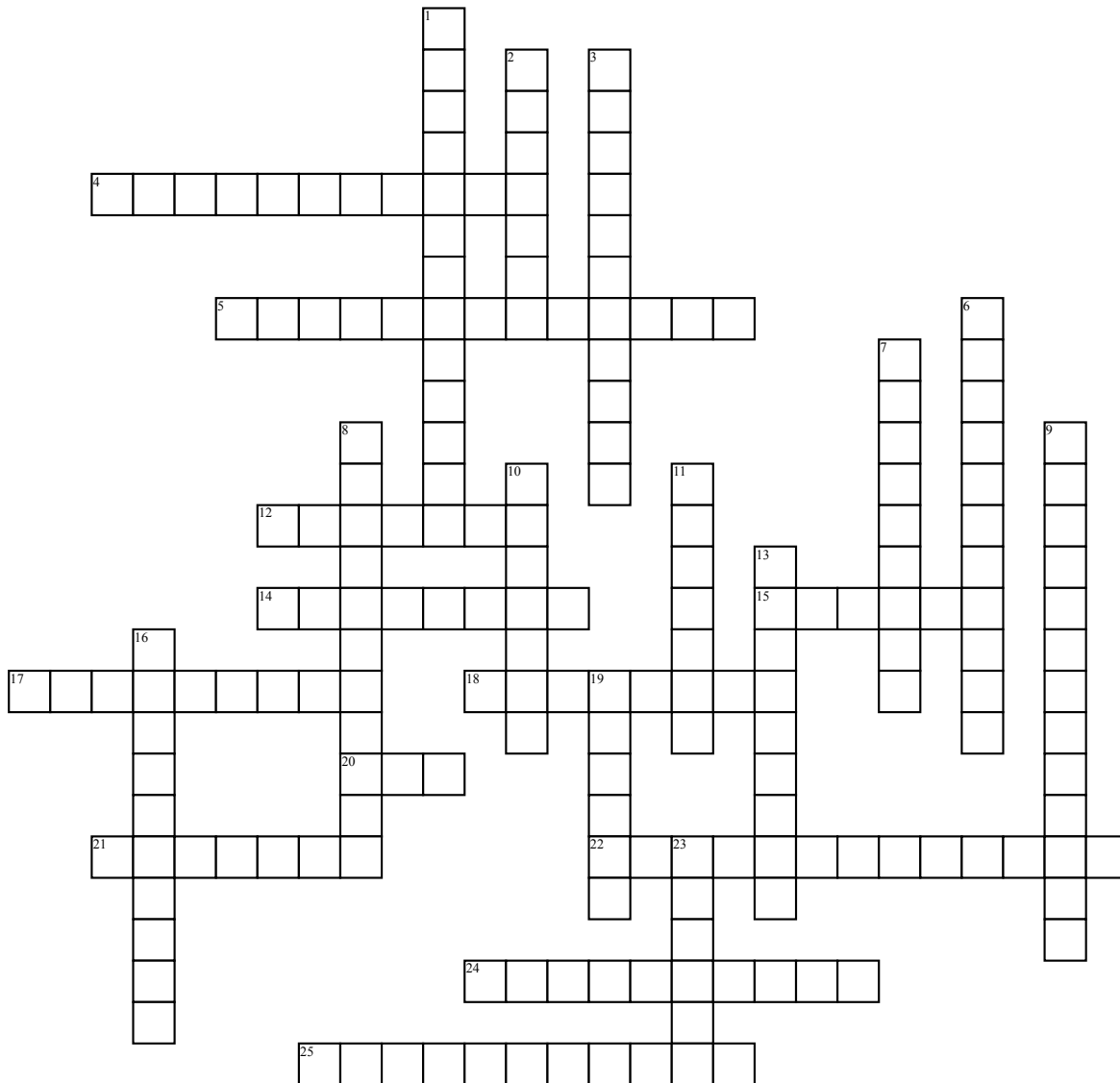


Crossword Puzzle Quiz
