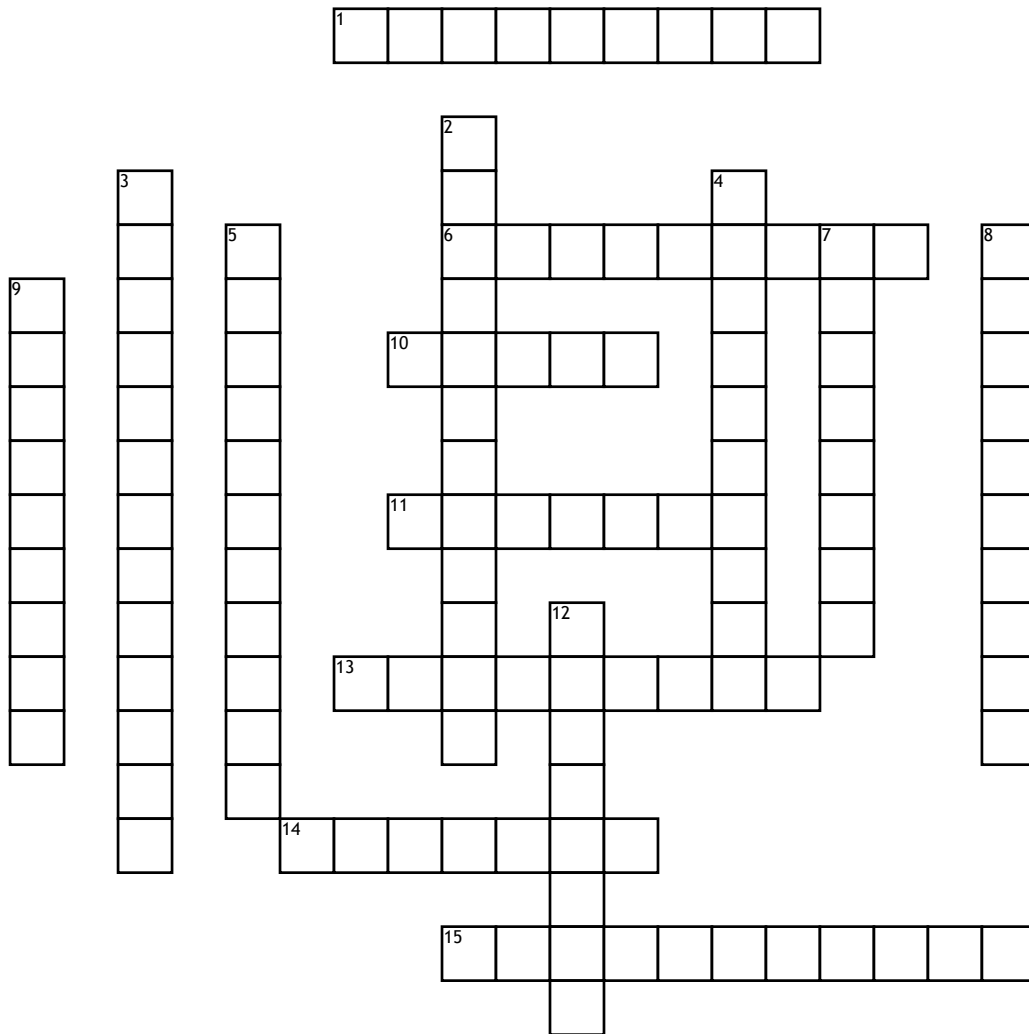


Crossword Puzzle - Vocab Collection Part 2
