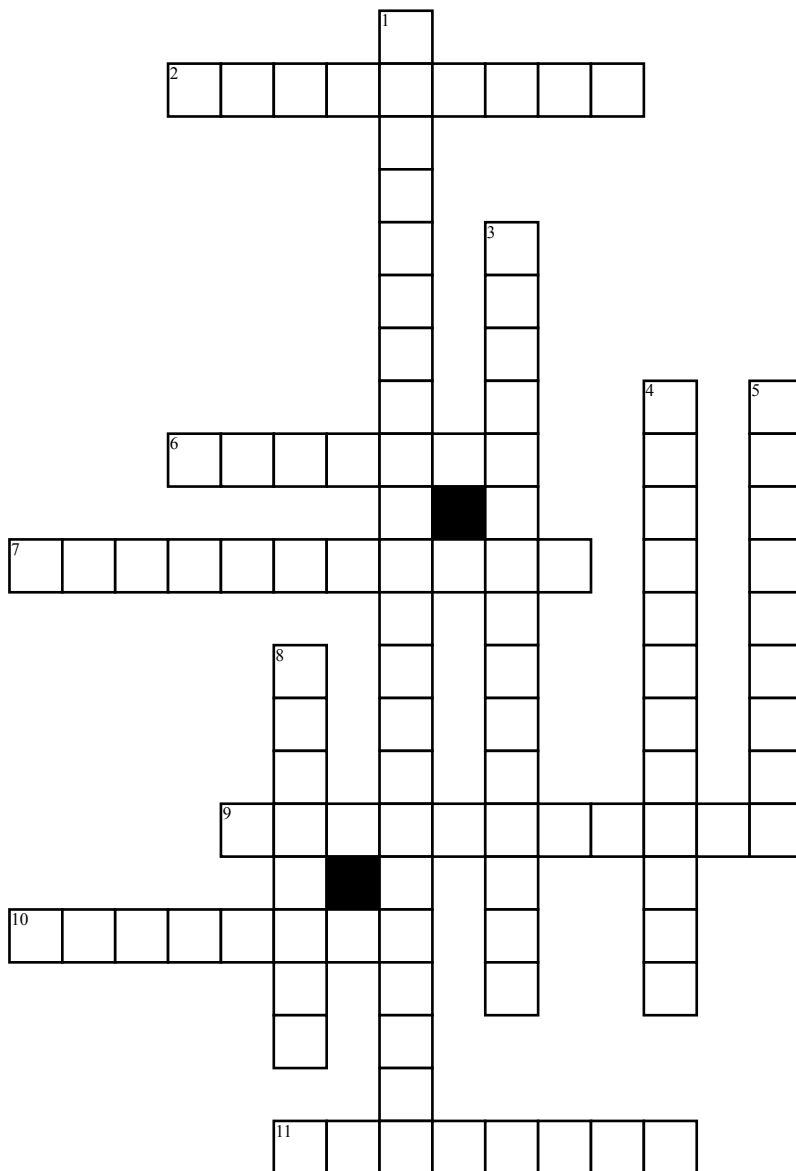


Crossword Puzzle Vocabulary
