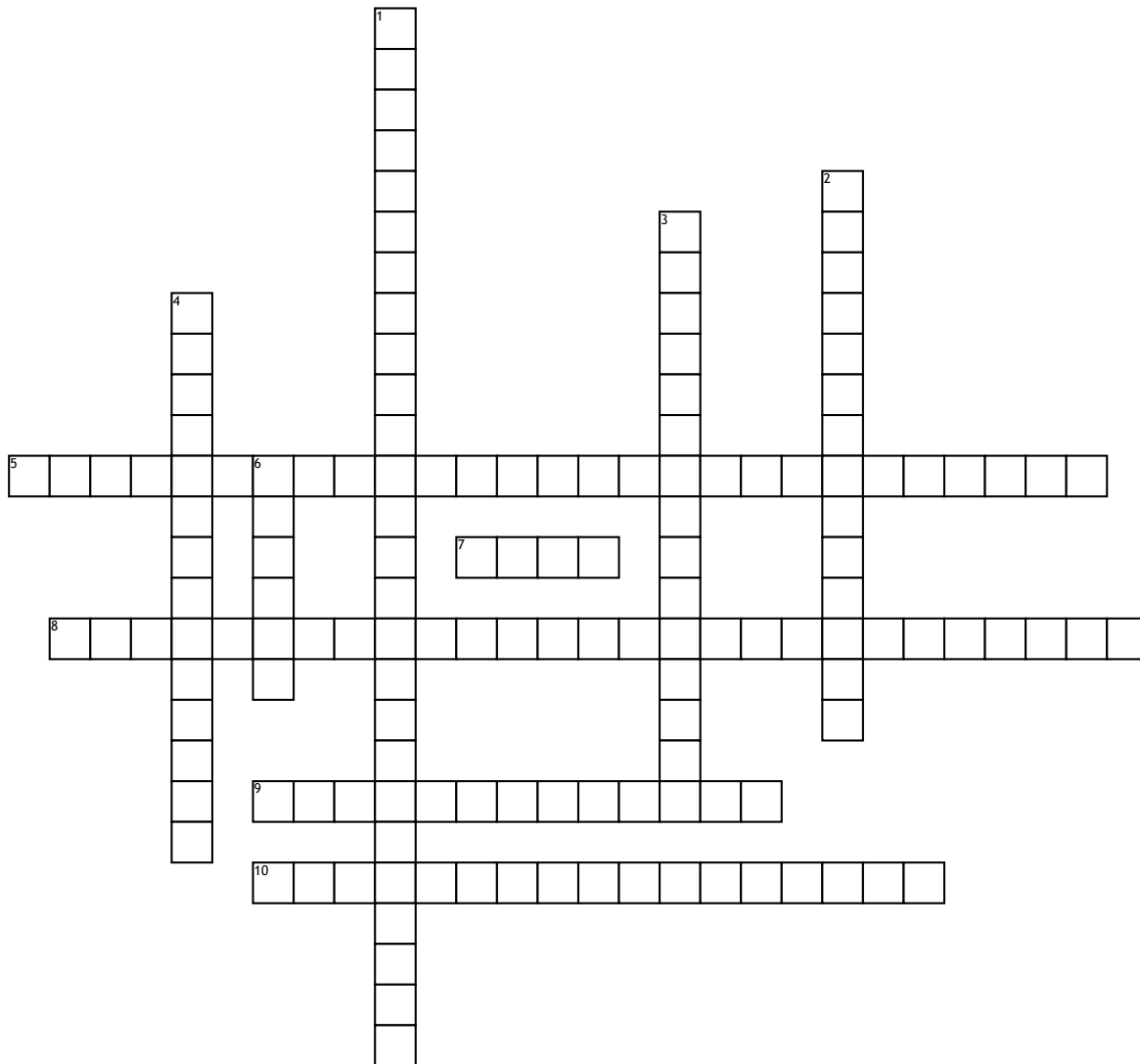

5. a condition of persistent mental and emotional stress occurring as a result of injury or severe psychological shock, typically involving disturbance of sleep and constant vivid recall of the experience, with dulled responses to others and to the outside world.

7. Neurodevelopmental psychiatric disorder. Significant problems with executive functions which cause attention deficits and hyperactivity.

8. is an anxiety disorder in which people have unwanted and repeated thoughts, feelings, images, and sensations obsessions and engage in behaviors or mental acts in response to these thoughts or obsessions.

9. a long-term mental disorder of a type involving a breakdown in the relation between thought, emotion, and behavior, leading to faulty perception, inappropriate actions and feelings, withdrawal from reality and personal relationships into fantasy and delusion, and a sense of mental fragmentation

10. also known as manic-depressive illness, is a brain disorder that causes unusual shifts in mood, energy, activity levels, and the ability to carry out day-to-day tasks.

1. a psychological disorder characterized by excessive or disproportionate anxiety about several aspects of life, such as work, social relationships, or financial matters.

2. any of a range of psychological disorders characterized by abnormal or disturbed eating habits

3. known as depression, is a mental disorder characterized by at least two weeks of low mood that is present across most situations. It is often accompanied by low self-esteem, loss of interest in normally enjoyable activities, low energy, and pain without a clear cause.

4. overindulgence in or dependence on an addictive substance, especially alcohol or drugs.

6. a mental condition, present from early childhood, characterized by difficulty in communicating and forming relationships with other people and in using language and abstract concepts.
