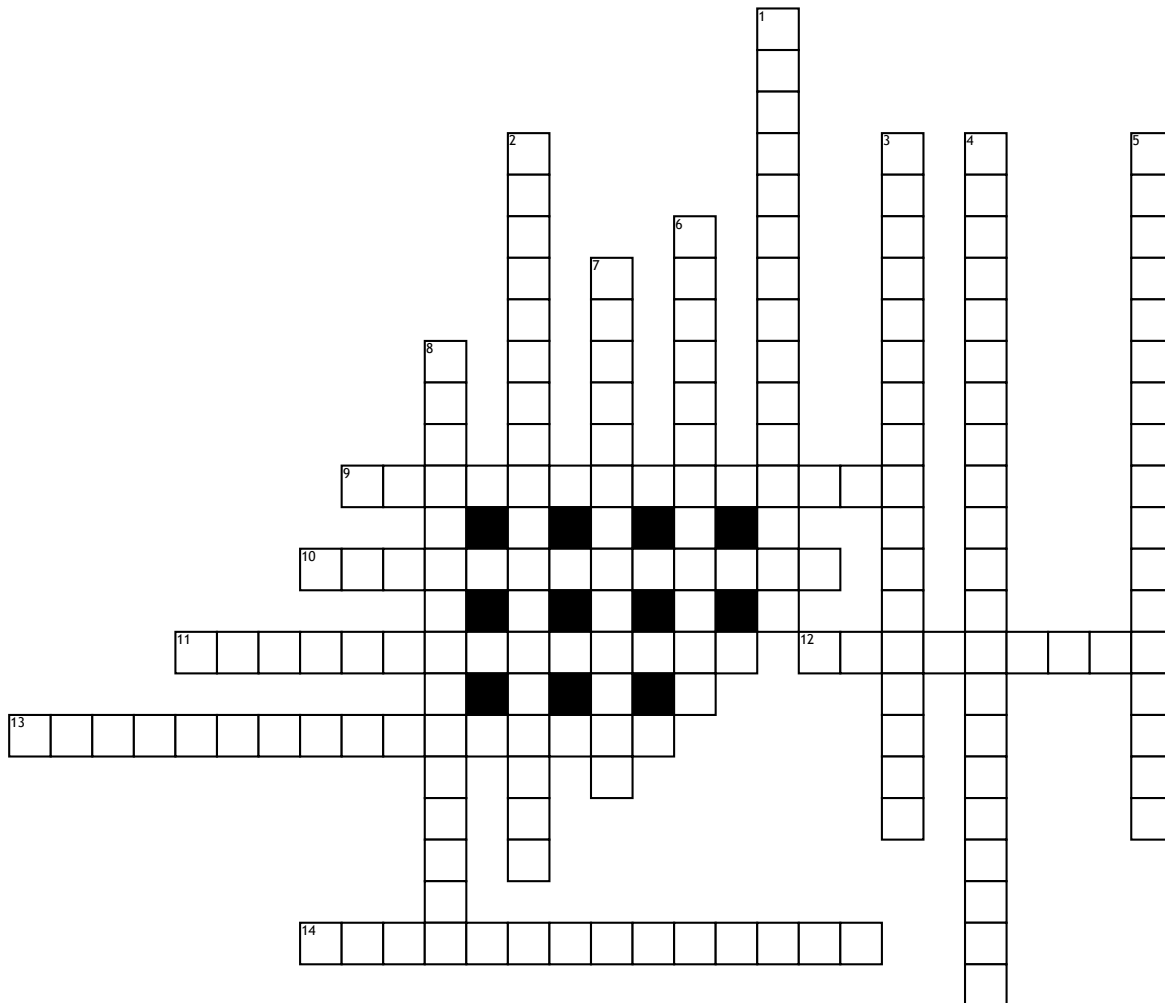


Crossword on b-law

- 9.** A contract that meets one or more specific requirements of construction
- 10.** A classification that permits a contract to be enforceable in case where no express or implied contract exists and one party suffers losses as a result of another party's unjust enrichment
- 11.** A contract that involves terms for both goods and services, the source of law is established by determining the predominant thrust of the subject matter
- 12.** Any meeting of the mind resulting in mutual assent to do or refrain from doing something

- 13.** A contract that one party may, at its option, either disaffirm or enforce
- 14.** The government body of law of contracts, services or real estate

- 1.** A contract in which the agreement is reached by the parties' actions rather than their words.
- 2.** A contract involving one promise followed by one performance, which then triggers a second performance from the offeror
- 3.** The body of law governing contracts for goods or products; based on the Uniform Commercial Code
- 4.** A contract that meets the elements required by law for an otherwise binding agreement but is subject to legal defense
- 5.** A contract involving two promises and two performances
- 6.** A contract that lacks one or more of the basic required elements of a contract or that has not been formed in conformance with the law from the outset of the agreement and, thus, cannot be enforced by either party.
- 7.** A contract that has the necessary elements and, thus, can be enforceable
- 8.** A contract that is created when the parties have knowingly and intentionally agreed on the promises and performances
