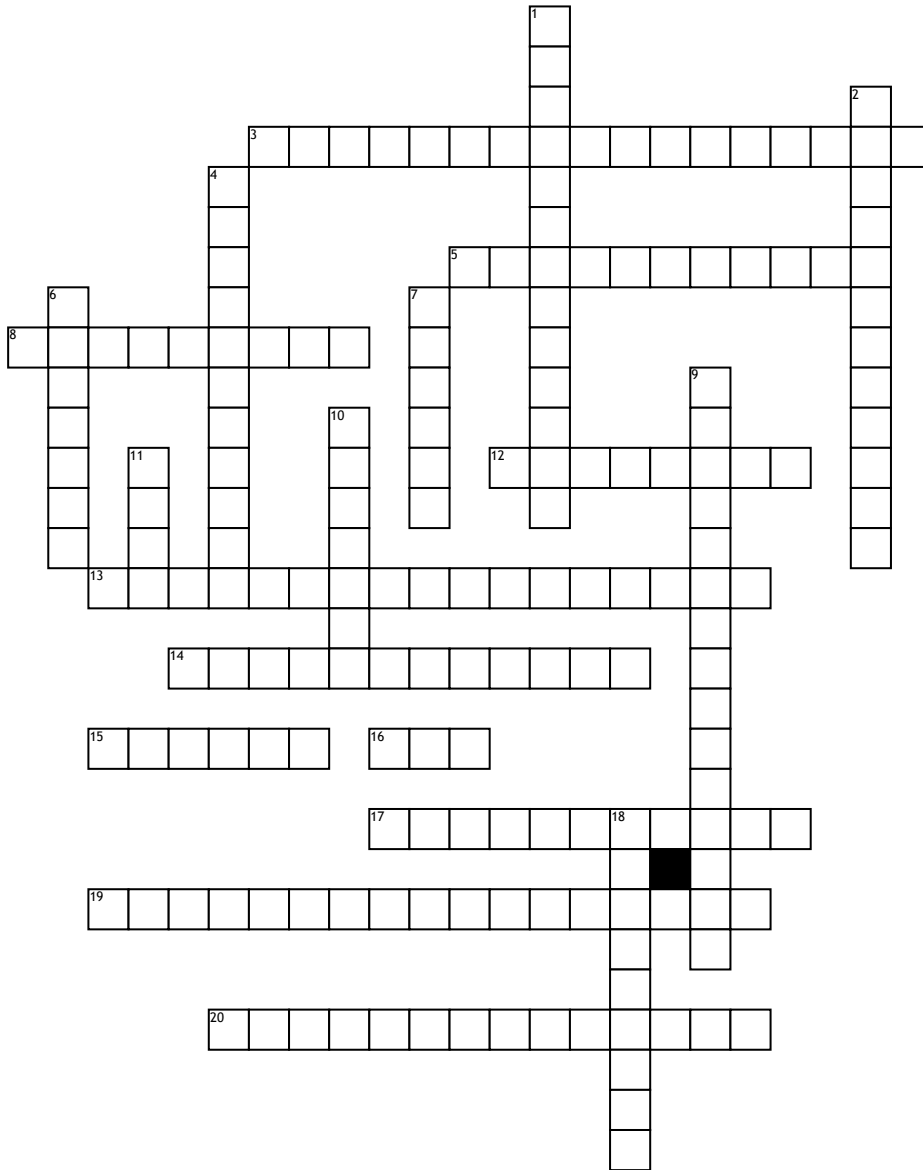


# Crossword puzzle
