
## DIGESTIVE SYSTEM

- **5.** is a hollow, uneven and median muscular organ of the pelvis, it is responsible for the collection of urine produced by the kidneys that reaches it through the ureters
- **6.** the activity of the glands, consisting in the elaboration and emission of certain substances
- 7. is a small hollow organ that is part of the digestive system that has the purpose of storing the bile produced by the liver and then releasing it in the small intestine during digestion
- **9.** it is the second step in the nutrition of living organisms
- 11. viscous mass into which foods are converted during the last phase of gastric digestion and in the first phase of the intestinal one
