

21. Uses of both human and natural resources to achieve higher standards of living

2. When the birth rate is higher than the death rate
4. A theory of population change over time that seeks to explain population increases and decreases through variations in the birth rate and death rate.

8. The ratio of age groups by sex within a population
10. The proportion of working people to non-working people in a country
