
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Desert Biome

- **2.** a desert plant: a plant needing very little water
- **4.** plants with an extremely long tap root
- 7. adaptation where animals move to find food and water during a drought
- **8.** a spring or pool of water formed when trapped underground water is forced through cracks in the rock layer
- **11.** a mass of tiny water droplets (cloud) floating close to the ground
- **13.** wall of dust as part of a dust storm
- **14.** like winter hibernation but done in summer to avoid arid desert climate
- 15. animals that are active at night

- **18.** a plant that grows on another plant or on a rock
- **19.** area of dry land on the sheltered side of a mountain
- **20.** adaptation that allows desert animals to blend into the rocky and sandy desert
- **21.** funnel or swirl of dust in monsoon season
- **22.** animals that are active at dawn and dusk

- 1. extended period without rain lasting months or years
- **3.** plants with very short life cycle; sprinters of the plant world

- **5.** process where green plants use sunlight to make food
- **6.** season of shifting winds resulting in severe thunderstorms
- **9.** a plant that stores water in its juicy stem, pads, or leaves
- **10.** no visibility from snowstorm in cold desert
- **12.** extremely hot and dry climate
- **16.** underground layer or rock with spaces where water is trapped
- 17. a desert animal: an animal needing little or no water
