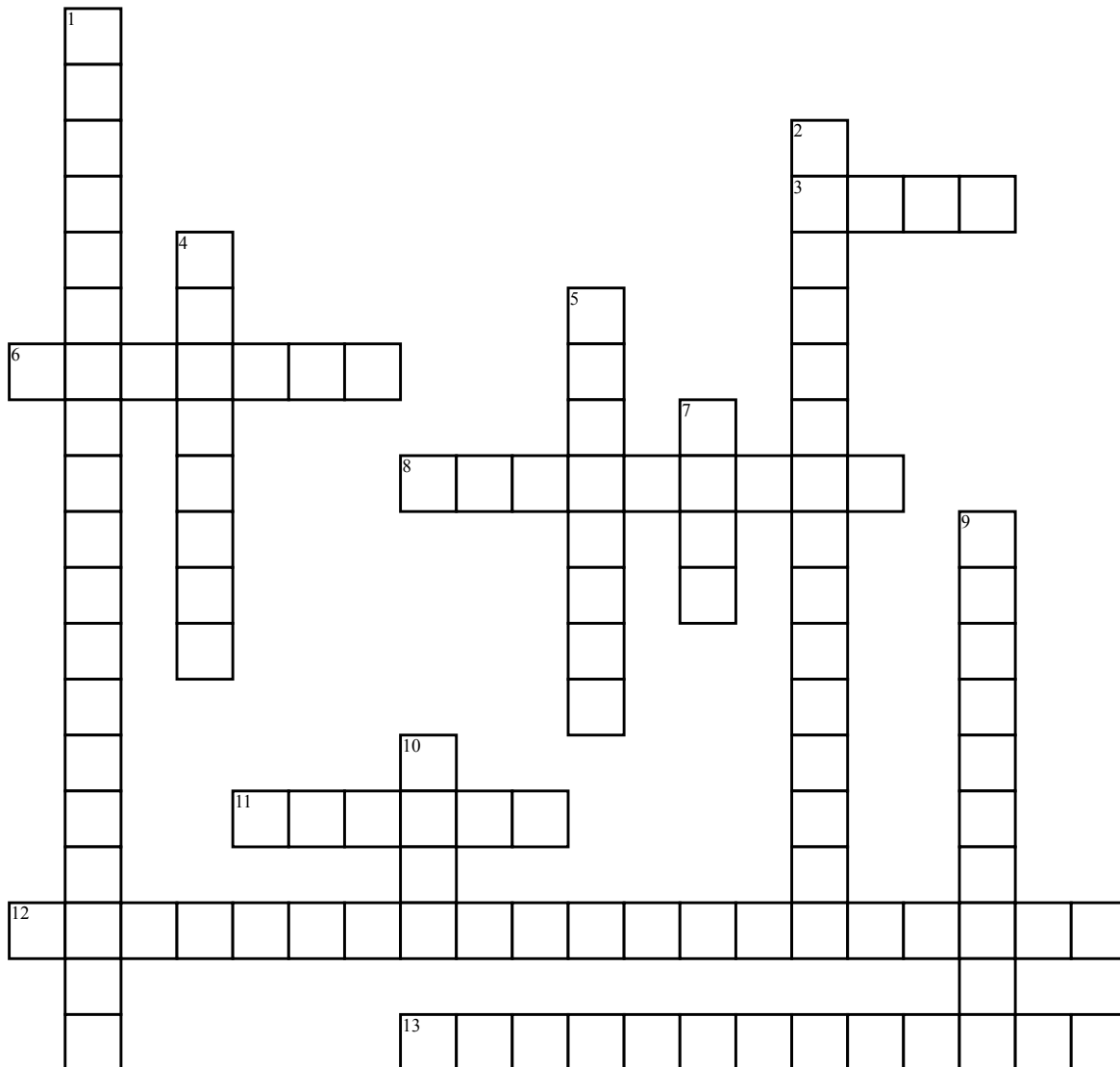


# Different Disorders



## Across

**3.** A chronic condition including attention difficulty, hyperactivity, and impulsiveness

**6.** a mood disorder in which the person alternates between the hopelessness and lethargy of depression and the overexcited state of mania

**8.** A nervous system disorder involving repetitive movements or unwanted sounds

**11.** A serious developmental disorder that impairs the ability to communicate and interact

**12.** characterized by the presence of two or more distinct personality states

**13.** characterized by disorganized and delusional thinking, disturbed perceptions, and inappropriate emotions and actions

## Down

**1.** Excessive thoughts (obsessions) that lead to repetitive behaviors (compulsions)

**2.** characterized by persistently depressed mood or loss of interest in activities, causing significant impairment in daily life

**4.** An eating disorder causing people to obsess about weight and what they eat

**5.** a persistent difficulty discarding or parting with possessions because of a perceived need to save them

**7.** characterized by haunting memories, nightmares, social withdrawal, jumpy anxiety, and/or insomnia that lingers for four weeks or more after a traumatic experience

**9.** a rare somatoform disorder in which a person experiences very specific genuine physical symptoms for which no physiological basis can be found

**10.** a tendency or craving to eat substances other than normal food (such as clay, plaster, or ashes), occurring during childhood or pregnancy, or as a symptom of disease.
