

- **2.** A length of timber with the vertical spacing of the bricks marked along one edge.
- **4.** A flexible ruler and used to measure distance.
- **10.** Used for putting a finish to the brick work.
- 12. Ideal for scooping
- **13.** Shorter face of the brick.

- **14.** This bond is very easy to lay
- **15.** Used as a wall is being built up to provide a guide for the bricks

- 1. These come in various shapes and sizes ranging between ten and fourteen inches.
- **3.** Each course is made up of alternate headers and stretchers.

- **5.** Check that the bricks are level
- **6.** All the bricks are plainly loaded on top of each other.
- 7. Used for cutting bricks.
- **8.** Used with either a bolster or cold chisel.
- **9.** Building material used to make walls, pavements and other elements.
- 11. Mainly used to construct strong one brick thickness walls.
