## Across

2. A length of timber with the vertical spacing of the bricks marked along one edge.
3. A flexible ruler and used to measure distance.
4. Used for putting a finish to the brick work.
5. Ideal for scooping
6. Shorter face of the brick.
7. This bond is very easy to lay
8. Used as a wall is being built up to provide a guide for the bricks

## Down

1. These come in various shapes and sizes ranging between ten and fourteen inches.
2. Each course is made up of alternate headers and stretchers.
3. Check that the bricks are level
4. All the bricks are plainly loaded on top of each other.
5. Used for cutting bricks.
6. Used with either a bolster or cold chisel.
7. Building material used to make walls, pavements and other elements.
8. Mainly used to construct strong one brick thickness walls.
