
Digestive System

2. Beneath the Stomach

6. located under the ribcage in the right upper part of the abdomen

7. absorbs water and salts, holds the resulting waste, and helps to digest the remaining food products

8. a pouch at the beginning of the large intestine that joins the small intestine to the large intestine

9. At the end of the esophagus, churns and mixes food with acids

1. Made up of three parts, the duodenum, the jejunum, and the ileum

3. It's hidden below the liver

5. muscular tube connecting the throat with the stomach, helps bring food down.
