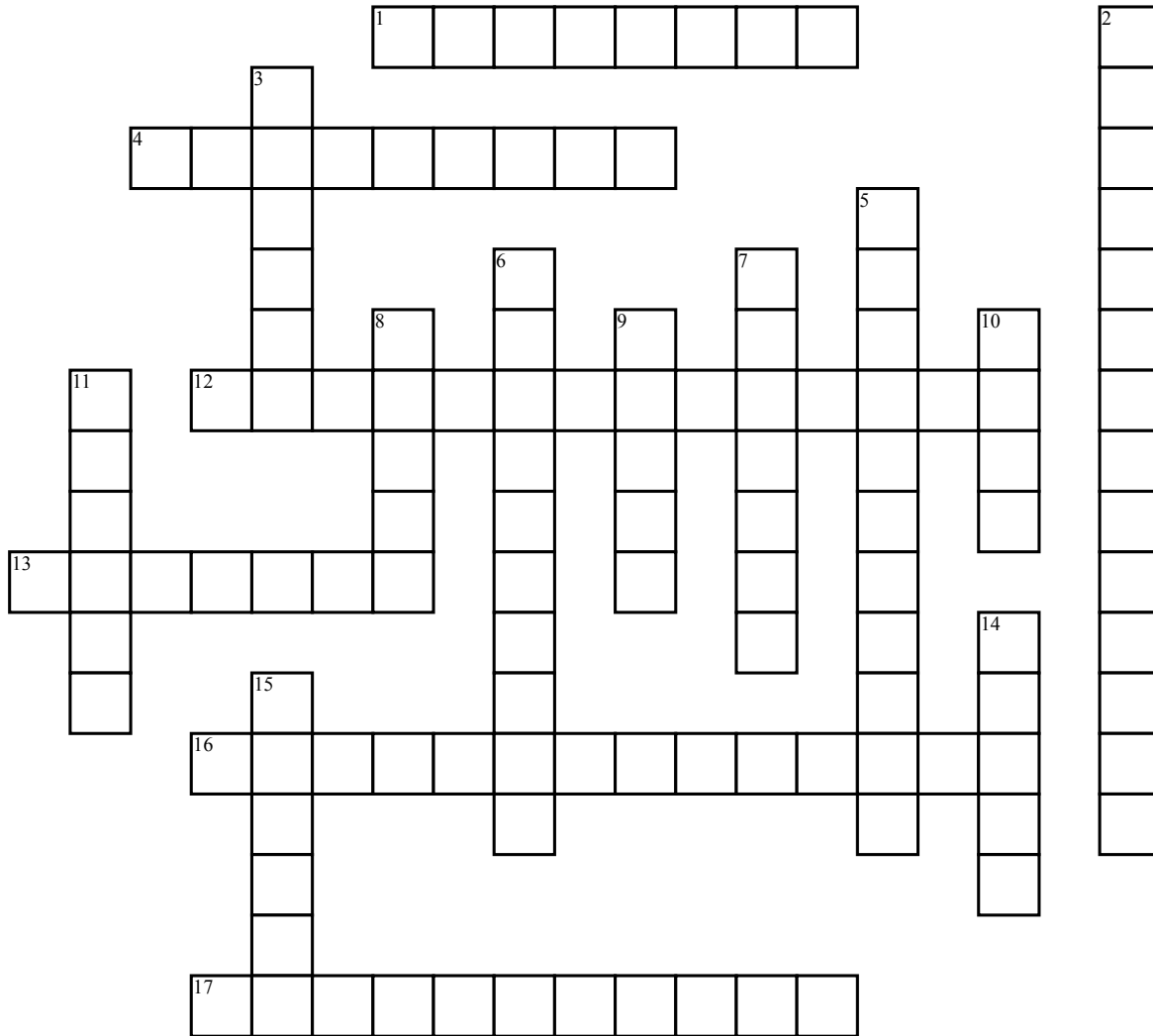


Digestive System

1. This organ secretes hormones and enzymes to help with the break down of fats, proteins, and carbohydrates.
4. A long tube about nine inches long.
12. The liver's most important job.
13. The functions are to store food, mix food, and pass food into the small intestine.
16. It works to absorb water and get rid of feces.
17. The main job is to store bile that the liver secretes.

2. A long tube helps break down food and finish the digestion process.
3. This moves the food around in the mouth.
5. Squeezing movements along the esophagus.
6. This flaps prevents food from going down your windpipe.
7. This connects your mouth to your nasal passageway and then to your esophagus.
8. This is where the process of digestion begins.

9. This organ secretes bile.

10. The exit point of the digestive system.

11. It is the last part of the large intestine and connects to the anus.

14. These help chop the food into smaller pieces.

15. This breaks down the food chemically and also helps clean teeth.
