

## Across

- **3.** Where mechanical (chewing) and chemical (amylase) digestion begins
- **5.** A short tube at the end of the large intestine where waste material is compressed into a solid form before being eliminated
- **7.** A muscular opening at the end of the rectum through which waste material is eliminated from the body
- **10.** The process by which nutrient molecules pass through the wall of the digestive system into the blood

- **12.** Large muscular sac that continues the mechanical and chemical digestion of food; pepsin digests protein
- **13.** Undigested, unabsorbed food discharged
- 14. Intake of food

## <u>Down</u>

- 1. Breakdown of food substances into simpler forms that can be absorbed and used; from large molecules (polymers) to small molecules (monomers)
- **2.** Digestive organ where most chemical digestion and absorption of food takes place

- **4.** The last section of the digestive system, where water is absorbed from food and the remaining material is eliminated from the body
- **6.** Involuntary waves of muscle contraction that keep food moving along in one direction through the digestive system.
- **8.** Food and liquid carrying tube connecting the mouth to the stomach
- **9.** Produces bile which emulsifies fats
- **11.** A substance produced by the liver that breaks up fat particles (emulsifies)
