

- 7. the comparatively straight, terminal section of the intestine, ending in the anus.
- **10.** the narrow, longer part of the intestines, comprising the duodenum, jejunum, and ileum, that serves to digest and absorb nutrients
- **12.** a gland, situated near the stomach, that secretes a digestive fluid into the intestine through one or more ducts and also secretes the hormone insulin.
- **14.** a pouch within the peritoneum that is the beginning of the mandible of the large intestine.

15. the process in the alimentary canal by which food is broken up, and converted into humans and certain animals, a substance for absorption and assimilation into the body

- 1. blind-ended tube connected to the cecum, from which it develops in the embryo.
- 2. the part of the alimentary canal consisting of the caecum, colon, and rectum. It extracts moisture from food residues, later excreted as faeces
- 3. the part of the mouth behind the teeth and the gums connecting with the inner part
- **5.** The act of taking food and drink into the body by the mouth

- **6.** a saclike enlargement of the alimentary canal, as in forming an organ for storing, diluting, and digesting food.
- **8.** the part of the alimentary canal between the pharynx and the stomach also called gullet
- 9. a large glandular organ located in the upper right side of the abdominal cavity, divided by fissures into five lobes and functioning in the secretion of
