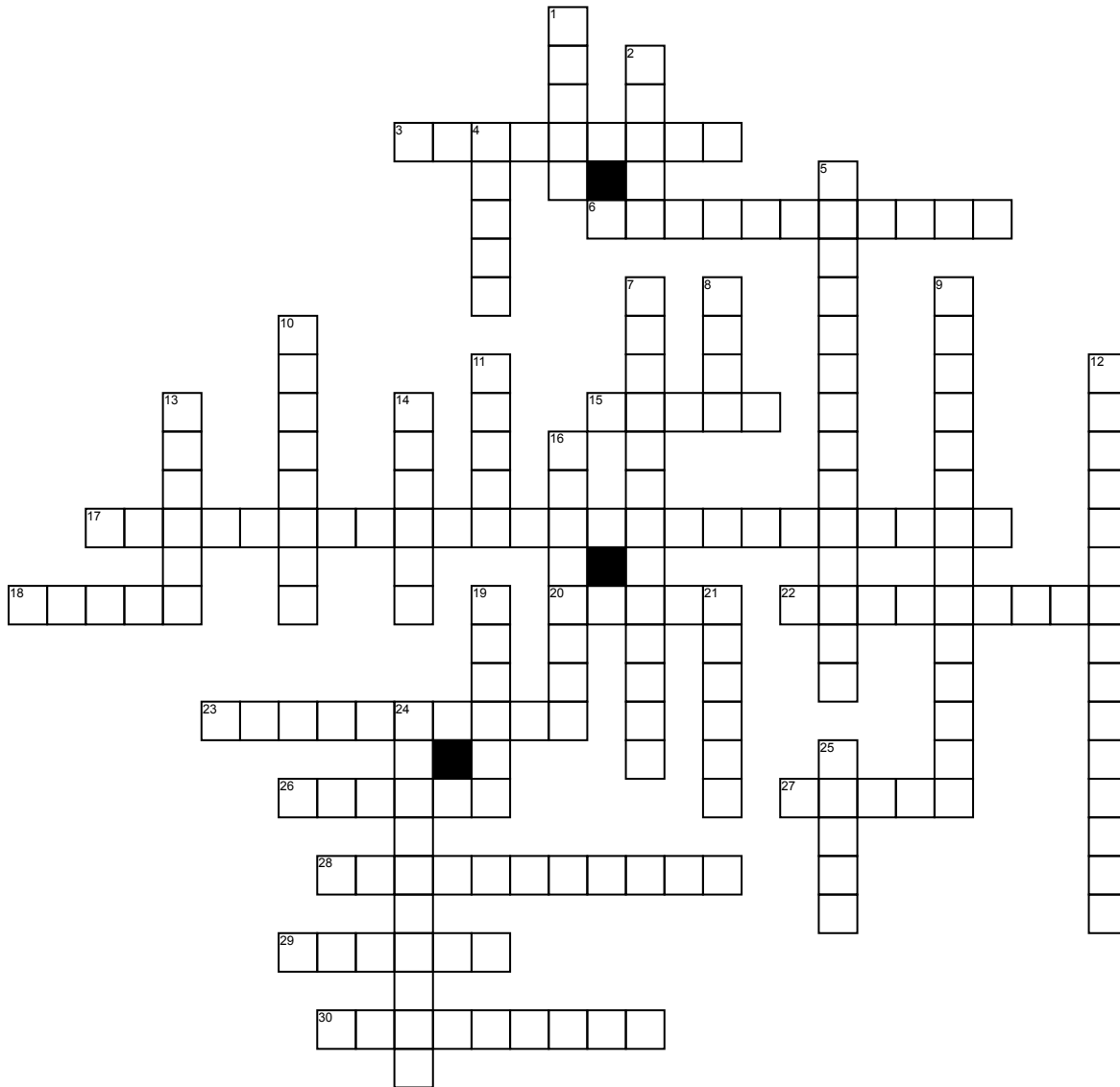


# Digestive system

3. You can find them on the surface of the tongue  
 6. organ on lower surface of the liver; stores bile  
 15. organ important in digestive and metabolic system functions; secretes bile  
 17. Upper right region of stomach  
 18. semisolid mass of partially digested food and gastric juices that passes from the stomach to the small intestine  
 20. folds on stomach lining  
 22. conversion of food into nutrients for the body and into waste products for release from the body.  
 23. chemical compounds that result from digestion of complex protein.  
 26. feeling sick in the stomach  
 27. cavity in the face in which food and water is ingested

28. coordinated, rhythmic contractions of smooth muscle that forces food through the digestive tract.  
 29. bottom portion of large intestine: connected to the anal cavity  
 30. part from the alimentary canal from the pharynx to the stomach.

 2. cone-shaped projection hanging down from soft palate

 5. place where reabsorption takes place  
 7. glands in the mouth that secrete fluids that aid in breaking down food

 12. This area divided to three parts: duodenum, ileum, jejunum

 19. fluid secreted by salivary glands  
 21. protein that causes chemical changes in substances in the digestive tract
