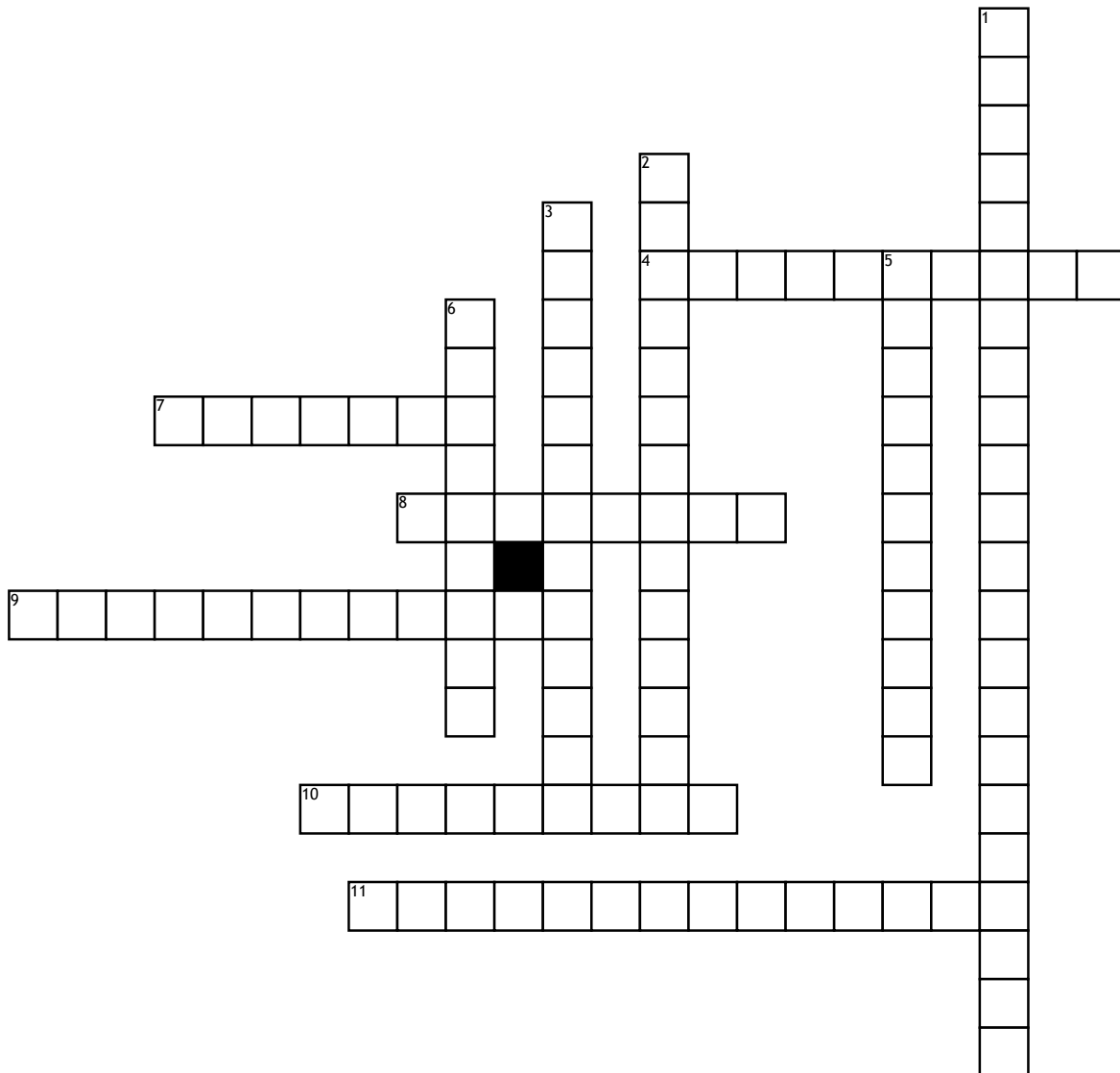

10. A means to identify people negatively as part of a particular group. The assumption is that 'they are all the same'.

2. The action of treating someone unfairly or less favourably compared to others.
3. Abuse that involves threats and constant criticism in order to undermine and control the person being abused.
