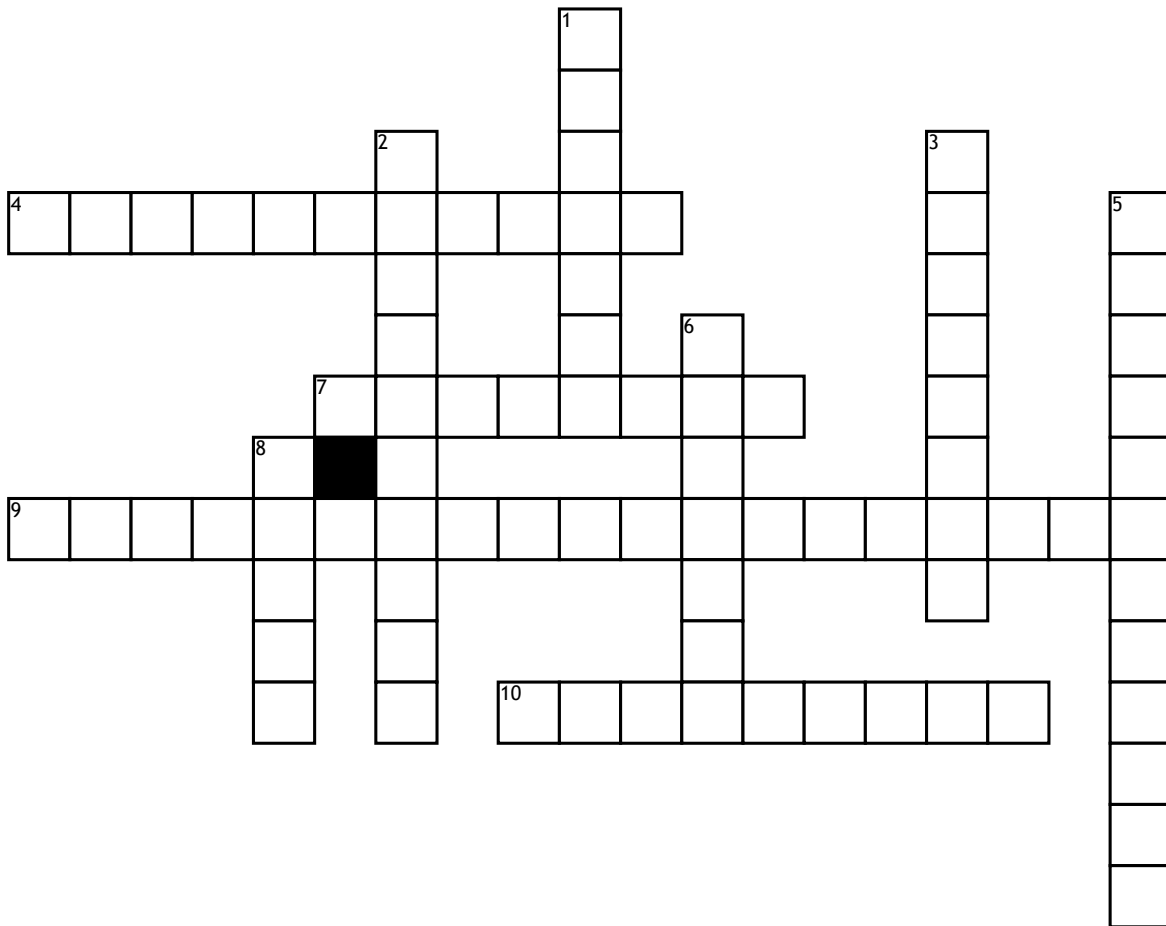


# Disease
