
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Disorders of the Endocrine System

- **6.** A softening and weakening of bones in children
- **8.** Hypersecretion of the growth hormone causes an overall increase in body size
- **10.** A disorder in adults in which the pituitary gland produces too much GH
- **11.** Hypothyroidism developing in infancy or early childhood
- **12.** Caused by hyposecretion of ADH from the posterior pituitary

- **15.** When the adrenal glands are damaged, producing insufficient amounts of cortisol
- **16.** A condition that occurs from exposure to high cortisol levels for a long time
- **18.** Deficiency of glucose in the bloodstream
- **19.** A condition caused by very low levels of glucose in the bloodstream

- **2.** A disease caused by excess production of aldosterone
- 4. Hyposecretion of the growth hormone that affects only height

- **5.** A swelling of the neck resulting from enlargement of the thyroid gland
- 7. Swelling of the neck and protrusion of the eyes due to an overactive thyroid gland
- **9.** A genetic disorder that makes XY fetuses unresponsive to male hormones
- **13.** A mood disorder characterized by depression that occurs at the same time every year

- **17.** A dermatological change that can occur in hypothyroidism
